Forest Green

Water spray bottle

Canvas: 4 x pre-primed canvases approx 350mm x 450mm, 1 x pre-primed canvas approx 500mm x 600mm

Brushes: 5 flat brushes in varying sizes (eg 2,6,8,10,12), + one large flat brush, approx 5cm across

Easel: your own robust freestanding or table top easel

Extras: a large water pot eg ice cream or yoghurt container
