## Day 1.

- Sleek and clean? Or scarred majesty? Create realism in your paintings using battle scars, barnacles and a raft of other tricks.
- Learn how to create "rays".
- Start to chalk in your whale for Day 2.

## Materials Needed:

### Paint:

Atelier Interactive (or whatever brand you use, similar colours)

- Titanium White (a lot)
- Permanent Alizarine
- Cadmium Yellow Light
- French Ultramarine Blue
- Pthalo Blue
- Burnt Umber
- Dioxazine Purple
- Atelier Universal Medium

### Brushes:

- Chisels (flats) x 4, various sizes eg 2, 6, 8, 12 and a large approx 5cm across house painting brush.

### Canvas:

- 2 x Pre-primed stretched canvas or board, approx 1000mm x 500mm

### Easel:

- Your own robust tabletop or freestanding easel.
