- Investigate how the light changes as the sun travels through the sky.
- Learn which colours predominate, and when.
- Simple exercises to help you understand the way light works.
- Unexpected colour. What can I get away with? And how much is too much?
- Learn how to use your palette in a more active, informed way to support each of your paintings.

Day 2:

- Using the knowledge and skills learned on Day 1, we'll work on a painting expressing colours late in the day.

A \$40 deposit will confirm your spot, and places are strictly limited to 12.

Materials Needed

Paint:

- Atelier Interactive colours (or whatever brand you use, similar colours)
- Titanium White
- Alizarin
- Naphthol Red Light
- Cadmium Yellow Medium
- Cadmium Yellow Light
- Pthalo Blue
- French Ultramarine Blue
- Dioxazine Purple
- Burnt Umber

Brushes:

- Chisels (flats) x 5 - various sizes eg 2, 6, 8, 10, 12, and 1 large housepainting brush approx 10cm across.

Canvas:

- Pre-primed canvas board or stretched x 4, approximately 350mm x 450mm, and 1 larger one approx 500mm x 600mm.

Easel:

- Your own robust tabletop or freestanding easel.
