  Matthew 5:41
- \* It is always <u>right</u> to do what is <u>right</u> and God rewards. *Mark 15:21, Romans 16:13*
- \* Carrying your cross is simply doing what <u>God</u> wants you to do even when it is <u>difficult</u>.

  Luke 9:23,24: 14:27
