Foolish- The Greek term carries the idea of a wrong attitude of heart, a lack of faith that clouds judgment. It does not connote mental deficiency but mental laziness and carelessness.

Titus 3:3-6. However, we don't have to be stupid (or idiotic) to act stupid. “O you dear idiots of Galatia”

Galatians 3:1 - Phillips translation.

Ask yourself these questions:
