- 7. The New Covenant *Jeremiah 31:31-37*An <u>unconditional</u> promise to <u>Israel</u> that applies to <u>everyone</u>

So what.....

Do <u>believe</u> in the promises which are for everyone. *Galatians 3:15-18* 

Do <u>not</u> <u>believe</u> in the promises which are <u>not</u> for everyone. *Galatians 3:19-29*

## "Are All God's Promises for Me?" Galatians 3:15-29

Covenants are God's major <u>Promises</u> made for <u>chosen</u> relationships. The covenant is a <u>binding</u> promise, agreement or treaty. As in a will or <u>trust</u> it expresses the desires, intent, and <u>commitment</u> of <u>one</u> party to other parties.

Some covenants are made equally by both parties in the agreement. Covenants made solely by God are <u>irrevocable</u>

Some promises are <u>conditional</u> and others are unconditional.
