Galatians 3:15-29

Covenants are God’s major Promises made for chosen relationships. The covenant is a binding promise, agreement or treaty. As in a will or trust it expresses the desires, intent, and commitment of one party to other parties. Some covenants are made equally by both parties in the agreement. Covenants made solely by God are irrevocable. Some promises are conditional and others are unconditional.

Biblical Covenants

1. The Adamic Covenant - *Genesis 2:15-17*

A conditional promise to Adam that affects everyone

2. The Noahic Covenant - *Genesis 9:12-15*

An unconditional promise to Noah that applies to everyone

3. The Abrahamic Covenant - *Genesis 15*

An unconditional promise to Abram that applies to everyone
