4. The Mosaic (Old) Covenant– *Exodus 19:3-6*A conditional promise to Israel that applies to Israel

5. The <u>Palestinian</u> Covenant– *Deuteronomy 30:5-7*An <u>unconditional</u> promise to Israel that applies to <u>Israel</u>

6. The <u>Davidic</u> Covenant– *II Samuel 7:8, 16-17; Luke 1:32-35*An <u>unconditional</u> promise to David that applies to <u>everyone</u>

7. The New Covenant– *Jeremiah 31:31-37*An unconditional promise to Israel that applies to everyone

Do <u>trust</u> in the promises which are for everyone. *Galatians 3:15-18*

Do <u>not trust</u> in the promises which are not for everyone.

A <u>conditional</u> promise to Adam that affects <u>everyone</u>

2. The Noahic Covenant– Genesis 9:12-15

An <u>unconditional</u> promise to Noah that applies to <u>everyone</u>

3. The Abrahamic Covenant- Genesis 15

An <u>unconditional</u> promise to Abraham that applies to <u>everyone</u>
