### **“Becoming Significant!” *Exodus 3***

#### **Is there a process?**

#### **1. You begin by thinking you are somebody!**

*Exodus 2:2- “The woman conceived and bore a son; and when she saw that he was beautiful, she hid him for three months.”*

*Acts 7:21,22- “And after he had been set outside, Pharaoh's daughter took him away and nurtured him as her own son. Moses was educated in all the learning of the Egyptians, and he was a man of power in words and deeds.”*

#### **2. You discover you really are not somebody!**

*Exodus 1:8- “Now a new king arose over Egypt, who did not know Joseph.”*

*Exodus 4:14- “Then the anger of the Lord burned against Moses, and He said, 'Is there not your brother Aaron the Levite? I know that he speaks fluently, And moreover, behold, he is coming out to meet you; when he sees you, he will be glad in his heart.'”*

**3. You encounter the One who is really Somebody!***Exodus 3***Who is God?**

He is Knowable. *Exodus 3:2, Luke 19:10*

He is Holy. *Exodus 3:5,6, I Peter 1:14-16*

He is the Way Out. *Exodus 3:7-9, John 8:31-34,*  
*John 14:6*
