Let's look in at the tomb

The tomb was looked in at and found empty!

The natural explanations for the empty tomb are <u>not</u> convincing.

- 1. The <u>swoon</u> theory
- 2. The theft theory
- 3. The wrong tomb theory
- 4. The <u>hallucination</u> theory

The supernatural explanation for the empty tomb makes sense

1. Jesus of Nazareth really <u>lived</u> and really <u>died</u>.

(Secular and Christian sources- Tacitus, Josephus, Suetonius, New Testament writers and archaeology)

- 2. Followers had experiences that they believed were physical appearances of Jesus. John 20:24-29
- 3. The event that impacted the world was fundamentally <u>based</u> on the resurrection.

 Acts 17:3, 6

- 4. Believers in the resurrection were willing to <u>die</u> for what they were convinced was <u>true</u> and not a <u>lie</u>.
- 5. The written <u>record</u> and proclamation of the resurrection was practically immediate.

 I Corinthians 15:3-8
- 6. James the half-brother of Jesus came to faith.
- 7. Paul the persecutor of the <u>church</u> came to faith.

The amazing impact the risen Jesus makes on lives

- 1. Knowing Jesus It doesn't get <u>any</u> better than this! *Philippians 3:7-8*
- 2. Believing in Jesus It makes you good enough. *Philippians 3:9*
- 3. Relying on Jesus It gives you <u>all</u> you need. *Philippians 3:10*
- 4. Being in Jesus It means your <u>future</u> is settled. *Philippians 3:11*
