<b>Respect Your Siblings</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>No fighting</li> <li>No ugly talking or name calling</li> </ul>	<b>Ephesians 4:2-3</b> With all lowliness and gentleness, with longsuffering, bearing with one another in love, endeavoring to keep the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace.	
<b>Be Polite at the Table</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Do not leave the table during meals without permission</li> <li>No toys or electronics at the table</li> <li>Be thankful for the food</li> </ul>	<b>Psalms 107:1</b> Oh, give thanks to the Lord, for He is good! For His mercy endures forever.	
<b>Keep Your Bedroom Neat</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Put your toys away after playing</li> <li>Clean up immediately when told to</li> <li>Do not take food or drink to your room</li> </ul>	<b>Proverbs 16:3</b> Commit your works to the Lord, and your thoughts will be established.
