This simple ebook will teach you 30 effective and fun-filled ways that your child can accept the Word of God, and therefore God's blessings, starting at a very young age, into his or her life.

Name of Scripture Memorization Technique:

Baby Alphabet Scripture Cards

Description:

A fun and easy way to teach the Bible verses to kids and young children using each letter of the alphabet.

Methodology:

Most children find it easy and enjoyable to memorize the alphabet because it's fun, right? This scripture memorization technique uses the letters of the alphabet as reference to help them get started.

1. Produce 27 pieces of 4 x 6 inches index cards bounded together.
2. On the first page, write "Baby Alphabet Scripture Cards" followed by your child's name in big, block letters.
3. Turn to the next page, and from here on out, choose a simple verse from the Bible in which the first letter of the first word corresponds to a certain letter of the alphabet in its correct order. 26 pages for the 26 letters of the alphabet. (give an example.)
4. Make sure the writing is very clear and legible.
5. Teach your child to memorize the content of each card. Feel free to take as long as necessary. This method does not involve any time limit whatsoever.

Name of Scripture Memorization Technique:

Modern Scripture Memorization Technique For Auditory Learners

Description:

This memorization technique harnesses the power of listening and speaking to easily learn the Bible verses by heart.

Methodology:

1. Produce a mobile phone for your child with a voice recording feature. If you feel like your child is too young to own one, a simple voice recorder is an ample alternative.
2. Choose a simple verse from the Bible. As much as possible make sure the child can relate to the meaning of the verse.
3. Have your child recite the verse out loud while recording it using the voice recorder or mobile phone.
4. Tell your child to listen to the recording three times a day – once in the morning, before lunch, and in the evening before going to bed.
5. When your child is ready, ask him to recite the verse along with the recording every time he or she listens to it, without reading from the Bible.
6. Move along to the next verse when your child has safely learned the Bible verse by heart.

Name of Scripture Memorization Technique:

Move Your Body And Memorize The Scriptures Technique

Description:

A technique which takes advantage of kids' love for body movement to learn the Bible verses. Great for children age 8 and up.

Methodology:

Children are always moving this way and that way, so full of life and energy. They will surely love this technique.

1. Choose a simple Bible verse that your child can relate to, and in your spare time, make up body movements and gestures that corresponds to certain words in the verse.
2. Teach your child what you've prepared and make him or her practice it once in the morning and once again in the evening before going to bed.
3. The words of the verse must be recited out loud along with the body movements, at first letting the child read from an index card for reference.
4. As the child learns the gestures by heart he or she begins to associate them with the words in the verse, and eventually full memorization will set in without the child realizing it.
5. Continue until the child is able to recite the verse without any references. Then, move on to the next Bible verse.

Name of Scripture Memorization Technique:

Summer Bible Verses Memorization Program

Description:

An efficient technique that takes advantage of summer vacations when school is out to teach your kids the Bible verses.

Methodology:

1. This Scripture memorization technique is most applicable during long vacations away from school—summer holidays, Christmas vacation, etc.
2. A child is capable of learning the Psalm 23 by the time he or she is 5 years old. While the family memorizes the Bible verses as a group, encourage your children to join in the activity.
3. Encourage competition among your children. The first one to memorize and recite a particular Bible verse, without notes, gets to enjoy a sweet treat afterwards.
4. Ask for their Grandpa's and Grandma's help. Grandparents tend to be more patient in general and they would surely love the interaction with their grandkids.

Name of Scripture Memorization Technique:

Stars For Candy Scripture Memorization Technique

Description:

Cultivate your child's willingness to memorize the Bible verses by setting goals and offering rewards.

Methodology:

1. Take note this memorization technique is best practiced with the whole family.
2. Take a 5 x 8 index card and list down everyone's names on it, at least those who are participating in the activity.
3. Stick it onto the refrigerator or somewhere on display where everybody could easily see it.
4. For every complete Bible verse memorized, that person gets a star on the index card beside his name.
5. Inspire competition by giving a reward to the first person who reaches a checkpoint, or a certain number of stars. A good set is multiples of 5 (5, 10, 15, 20, etc).
6. Popular rewards are sweets, candies, chocolate and stuff toys.
7. Children love this since their names on the index card is on display for everyone to look at, they're much more inspired to work harder and achieve memorizing more Bible verses!

Name of Scripture Memorization Technique:

Kiddie Tunes Bible Verses Memorization Style

Description:

Children's songs provide an effective method for teaching the Bible verses to the little kids.

Methodology:

1. First and foremost, your child must be old enough to have learned children's songs by heart for this technique to be effective.
2. This requires a little creativity on your part. Take your kid's favorite children song and replace the lyrics with verses found from the Bible.
3. Have your child "sing" the Bible verse to the tune of the children's song. It's okay at first to let them read the words from a small piece of paper.
4. If possible, secure a music-only audio copy of the children's song and ask your child to sing along with it. You can sing along with him or her – it's fun!
5. As your child slowly begins to memorize the Bible verse, tell him to keep singing and practicing but this time no longer looking at any references. He or she will eventually get the whole song right and at the same time memorize the Bible verses.
6. Move on to the next song with a new Bible verse as lyrics.

Name of Scripture Memorization Technique:

Memorize The Bible Verses Using Word Strips

Description:

Word Strips is a fun game that helps your child memorize the Scriptures at the same time.

Methodology:

1. Pick a simple verse from the Bible. If possible, choose a verse that your child can easily relate to.
2. Take a single page of bond paper and draw rectangular boxes on it. Inside one of the boxes, write a word from the verse you've chosen and then the next. Keep at it until all the words of the verse have been written inside the boxes.
3. Make sure the writing is clear and legible. Use big, block letters.
4. Get a scissor and cut the boxes individually, creating word strips.
5. First, ask your child to read the verse from the Bible. Then jumble the word strips and ask your child to rearrange them in the correct order.
6. He or she does not have to get it right the first time. Keep practicing and eventually your child will get better at retaining the correct Bible verse in his or her head.
7. This memorization technique is even more fun when played with friends. Ask the neighbor's friend to come over during playtime and help out.
8. Move on to the next Bible verse and repeating the previous steps to create word strips.

Name of Scripture Memorization Technique:

Copywork Of Bible Verses For Children

Description:

This technique teaches Scripture memorization as well as practices your child's handwriting at the same time.

Methodology:

1. Purchase a complete set of copyworks for children memorizing Bible verses. These are quite common and you can find them in your nearest bookstore.
2. Choose one Bible verse out of the complete set, and then ask your child to sit down and work on the copywork—basically, rewriting the Bible verse again and again in the space provided until memorization is achieved through repetition.
3. At the same time, the process of rewriting the Bible verse helps your child improve his or her penmanship.
4. For best results, ask your child to study the copywork during a fixed specific time of day so it's easier to get into the habit of memorizing Scripture.

Name of Scripture Memorization Technique:

Alphabetic Bible Verses Index Cards With Illustration

Description:

Aid your child to memorize the Bible verses using pictures and the alphabet as point of references.

Methodology:

The alphabet is easy for kids to memorize, and so are pictures. This memorization technique uses both to improve learning

1. Get 26 pieces of 5 x 8 index cards and bound them together in one corner.
 2. On the first page, pick a simple verse from the Bible. The verse must contain at least a single letter A anywhere in the sentence.
 3. Write down the verse clearly on the index card, while highlighting the letter A using a red pen.
 4. Underneath, draw a picture that best represents the verse.
 5. Continue on the next page until you've used all 26 letters of the alphabet.
 6. Make sure the writing is very clear and legible.
 7. Teach your child to memorize the content of each card. Feel free to take as long as necessary.
- This method does not involve any time limit whatsoever.

Name of Scripture Memorization Technique:

Bible Verse Memorization Coloring Book

Description:

Encourages your child to memorize Scripture through his or her love for coloring books!

Methodology:

Children love coloring books and can't resist the sight of them unfinished. In this regard...

1. Purchase a coloring book based on your child's favorite characters—Disney characters, Loony Tunes, Pixar's, etc.
2. Find a small glass bowl, then choose at least 10 simple Bible verses and write them each on thin strips of paper, fold them up, and then throw them into the bowl as some sort of raffle.
3. Ask your child to take one slip of paper from the bowl and then show him or her the coloring book. But first, he or she must memorize the simple Bible verse on the slip of paper.
4. After your child has memorized a Bible verse, move on to the next raffle until the coloring book has run out of pages, at which point you need to purchase a new one.

Name of Scripture Memorization Technique:

Bag Around Scripture Memorization Technique

Description:

This simple game involving a paper bag teaches your child to easily memorize the Bible verses.

Methodology:

1. Find a spare grocery paper bag lying around and a small group of kids to play the game.
2. Choose a simple verse from the Bible to be memorized by the kids.
3. On top of the bag, use a marker to write down the Scripture reference on the bottom of the paper bag, and then break down the verse into four phrases and write them down each on the four sides of the paper bag.
4. Ask for a volunteer from the group who would “teach the verse to his or her friends.” Then ask the volunteer to step up in front of everyone and put the paper bag over his or her head. This will be fun!
5. To teach the Bible verse to the rest of the children of the group, ask the volunteer to bow his head and the group must recite the Scripture reference they see written on the bottom of the paper bag.
6. The volunteer stands upright and the group reads the first part of the verse written on one side, which the volunteer then proceeds to turn clockwise until the entire Bible verse has been read.
7. Ask another volunteer from the group. The children will love this game and they’ll certainly learn the Bible verse at the same time.

Name of Scripture Memorization Technique:

Step Forward Game For Memorizing The Bible Verses

Description:

Children love games, and this Scripture memorization technique will help them to love the Bible verses just as much!

Methodology:

1. Produce several colored sheets of construction paper and a small group of kids to play the game.
2. Choose a simple verse from the Bible to be memorized by the kids.
3. Break down the Bible verse into four or more phrases and, using a marker, write them on one side of a construction paper each.
4. Ask for volunteers and have them hold a construction paper out in front of them towards the group, each child standing so the Bible verse in its entirety can be read from left to right.
5. Tap a child on the shoulder as a signal to take one step forward so the group can recite the words written on his or her construction paper. Repeat until all the volunteers have stepped forward.
6. To facilitate memorization, this time, the volunteer must, when tapped on the shoulder, step forward and turn around so his or her construction paper is hidden from view. Have the group recite the entire Bible verse every time a volunteer steps forward and turns around on your cue.
7. Rotate the volunteers among the group until everyone has memorized the Bible verse!

Name of Scripture Memorization Technique:

Pull It Out Scripture Memorization Game

Description:

This is a fun game that can keep the children guessing until they've memorized the Bible verse!

Methodology:

1. Produce a small box and cut a small hole on top of it.
2. Choose a simple Bible verse and break it into several individual phrases written on thin strips of paper.
3. Using a thin sash cord, attach the strips of paper along the cord separated by about 6 inches each. On one end of the cord attach a small sweet reward such as candy or chocolate. Slide the cord into the box so that the other end of it is sticking out from the hole on top of the box.
4. First, ask the children to memorize the verse using the Bible as reference.
5. When everyone is ready, ask a volunteer to slowly pull the cord out and guess the words on the first slip of paper that comes up.
6. If the child makes the correct answer, continue pulling until the next slip of paper. If the child gets it wrong, pick another volunteer from the group.
7. Whoever makes all the right answers up to the last of slip of paper gets the reward. Children will love this game, that is a guarantee!

Name of Scripture Memorization Technique:

There's An App For That Scripture Memorization Technique

Description:

Technology is so much closer to our children and the youth, and we can use that to teach them the Bible verses.

Methodology:

1. Your child must be old enough to handle laptops and gadgets. If he or she loves to play games on your iPhone or iPad, that age is just about right.
2. Use Google to search for websites that allow you to download apps intended for teaching Scripture memorization to children. There are currently several such services available online for free.
3. Depending on the app you choose to download, the instructions on how to proceed with the Scripture memorization may differ. It is best to follow the instructions provided by the creator of the app.
4. If you do not own a smartphone or tablet, your child can memorize Scripture directly from the laptop or computer instead.

Name of Scripture Memorization Technique:

Camping Out Bible Memorization Guide

Description:

Children are more likely to focus when they are in a completely different environment than the one they're used to. This Scripture memorization guide takes advantage of that.

Methodology:

1. What kid doesn't love flashlights? Produce a flashlight and a blunt-ended stick, preferably a twig or a small branch that's been trimmed and cleaned.
2. Choose a simple verse from the Bible, one that your child can relate to.
3. In the evening, before bedtime, sit on the bed with your child and draw the covers above your heads.
4. Prop up the twig to make a small tent in the dark and switch on the flashlight. Use this quiet and meaningful environment to study and learn the verse with your child. In this environment, it is much easier to retain information compared to when you force him or her to study during the day when there are lots of distractions.

Name of Scripture Memorization Technique:

Memorizing The Bible Verses By Turning On The Light Of The Lord

Description:

This technique requires basic electrical training on your part or, even better, just hire an electrician to set everything up for you.

Methodology:

1. Buy a standard eraser board and a marker to write with.
2. Hang it on the wall opposite your child's bed so it is the first thing he or she sees in the morning and the last thing before going to bed.
3. Hire an electrician to mount a small bulb on top of the eraser board and have the switch easily accessible along the head of the bed.
4. Choose a simple verse from the Bible which your child can relate to.
5. Write down this verse on the eraser board and instruct your child to read it first thing in the morning and once before going to bed at night by switching on the "light of the Lord". Your child will love this simple act.
6. Every few weeks or so, once your child has fully memorized the verse, choose a new verse from the Bible and write it onto the eraser board for your child to learn.

Name of Scripture Memorization Technique:

Let's Go Camp! Bible Memorization Method

Description:

This training method uses a child's sense of wonder and excitement to help him or her memorize the Scriptures.

Methodology:

1. Determine the kind of outdoor activity that your child loves to do. Does he like swimming, playing with his friends in the playground, or camping?
2. Let's say your child loves camping. Why not schedule a camping trip during one of your free weekends?
3. Bring a Bible with you during the camping trip.
4. Choose a simple verse from the Bible that your child can relate to.
5. Every chance you get, take a moment to read or recite the Bible verse with your child. He or she will appreciate dearly since you'd taken the time and trouble to spend the entire day with him or her doing the thing he or she loves.
6. Move on to new verse for your next camping trip.

Name of Scripture Memorization Technique:

Memorizing The Scriptures With An Accountability Partner

Description:

Learning the Bible verses is much easier when your child has a partner he or she can learn with at the same time.

Methodology:

1. Find a partner for your child who is also having trouble learning the Bible verses. It helps if the partner is about the same age or close to that of your child, but not necessary.
2. Choose a simple verse from Bible your child can relate to.
3. Teach the Bible verse to your child and his or her partner.
4. Then ask them to help each other memorize the Bible verse by encouraging each other in times of difficulty. Maintain a healthy habit by setting aside a specific time of the day, every day, for Scripture memorization.
5. If you can't find a partner for your child, you can always stand in as the partner instead.

Name of Scripture Memorization Technique:

Learn To Read, Learn The Bible Verses

Description:

Learning is reading. Knowing that, why not combine the two activities in order to help your child memorize the Bible verses!

Methodology:

1. The best time for this technique is when your child is at an age when he or she about to enter school and learn how to read.
2. Choose a very simple verse from the Bible.
3. Take a few hours every day to teach your child how to read. But instead of using a school textbook or children's book, use the Bible verses instead. Your child will comes to memorize the verse and its meaning as he or she, slowly but surely, learns how to read.

Name of Scripture Memorization Technique:

Scripture Memorization Through Roleplay

Description:

Memorization is indeed difficult when it's confined to just a single activity – reading. Why not make a stage play out of it?

Methodology:

1. This particular memorization technique is best utilized when learning longer passages with your child or a group of children.
2. Choose a longer passage from the Bible.
3. Take note of the characters in the passage, and assign each role to a child who will act it out as if in a movie or stage play.
4. Ask the children to read their lines while re-enacting the event as they imagine it from the Bible. Encourage them to use motion and gestures to make the activity seem and feel more life-like.
5. Repeat as necessary, changing a few gestures here and there to add variety. Children will love this.
6. Move on to a new passage after the children have completely memorized the previous one.

Name of Scripture Memorization Technique:

Remember The Bible Verses Technique

Description:

Do not forget that reviewing and retaining what you have learned in your head is still a big part of Scripture memorization. This technique is all about that.

Methodology:

1. This technique is best utilized when your child has memorized at least 5 or more Bible verses.
2. Produce a number of 3 x 5 index cards and write down on them the Bible verses that your child has already gone through and memorized.
3. Ask your child to carry the index cards in his pocket whenever he or she leaves the house – to go to school, the neighbor's, camping during weekends, etc.
4. Instruct him or her to read and review the index cards from top to bottom so the Bible verses he or she has learned so far are refreshed in his or her mind every day.
5. This way, your child will never forget a single Bible verse a day in his or her life.

Name of Scripture Memorization Technique:

Memorizing By Writing The Bible Verses

Description:

With widespread internet connection these days, writing longhand is quickly becoming a lost art. Did you know that writing longhand also helps in memorization?

Methodology:

1. This technique is best utilized when your child is old enough to write words and understand his writing.
2. Choose a simple verse from the Bible your child can easily relate to.
3. Get a pen and piece of paper and ask your child to sit down and write the Bible verse in its entirety in longhand.
4. Instruct your child to keep writing the same verse over and over until he or she is able to safely memorize it in his or her head.
5. As a final step, ask your child to write down the Bible verse on a clean sheet of paper without looking at any references.
6. Move on to the next Bible verse.

Name of Scripture Memorization Technique:

Fixed schedule For Scripture Memorization

Description:

Setting up a good study habit is perhaps one of the best and most effective ways for your child to learn the Bible verses.

Methodology:

1. Choose a simple verse from the Bible that your child can relate to.
2. Teach your kid the importance of a good study habit. For 30 minutes after waking up, before lunch, and before bedtime, he or she must open the Bible and attempt to study and memorize the Bible verse.
3. You might have to accompany him or her during the first couple of days to make sure your child keeps his or her end of the bargain. But once a good study habit has been developed, you can rest assured your child will study on his or her own, and according to schedule.

Name of Scripture Memorization Technique:

Stick It On A Post It Note Bible Memorization Technique

Description:

Sometimes the best way to learn a Bible verse is to make it a constant part of your child's life.

Methodology:

1. Choose a simple Bible verse that your child can relate to.
2. Produce five to seven Post It notes and write the same verse on each and every one of them.
3. Take these notes and post them around the house, preferably in places your child like to frequent the most (kitchen, bedroom, playroom, comfort room, etc).
4. Instruct him or her to take a minute or two to read and reflect on the message of the verse whenever he or she sees one of the Post It notes. This method of frequent learning helps a lot in the memorization process of the Scripture.
5. Move on to the next Bible verse after your child has completely memorized the previous one.

Name of Scripture Memorization Technique:

Structured Learning Technique For Bible Verses

Description:

Some children learn better by following a certain structure that complements their natural way of thinking. This technique aims to achieve just that.

Methodology:

1. Choose a simple verse from the Bible your child can relate to.
2. Make it clear to him or her that the two of you will study a Bible verse for a certain period (one hour is recommended) during a specific time of the day.
3. Encourage structured learning by reviewing the Bible verse in this manner:
 - a. Recite the topic you've personally assigned to the Bible verse
 - b. Recite the Scripture reference
 - c. Quote the verse
 - d. Recite the Scripture reference once again
4. Repeat this method every day with your child until you have fully memorized the Bible verse.
5. Move on to the next verse in the Bible.

Name of Scripture Memorization Technique:

Draw As You Learn The Bible Verses Memorization Technique

Description:

Some child are more visual than auditory learners. For the former, this is how you teach them the Bible verses.

Methodology:

1. Pick a simple verse from the Bible your child can understand and relate to.
2. Ask your child to sit down at the table for his or her daily Bible study period.
3. Produce a clean sheet of paper and some crayons or colored markers.
4. On the top of the page, write down the verse in big, block letters.
5. Instruct your child to read the verse out loud. Tell him or her to remember whatever comes to his or her mind upon reading the Bible verse.
6. Then ask your child to draw the image on the same paper while still reciting the Bible verse. This combination of reading and drawing helps a lot in retaining the Bible verse in his or her mind. In addition, children love drawing activities.

Name of Scripture Memorization Technique:

Decoding The Bible Verses Memorization Technique

Description:

Children love adventures, and this adventure-like technique will have them memorizing Scripture in no time.

Methodology:

1. Pick a simple verse from the Bible, preferably a short one.
2. You need to prepare a simple code ahead of time where each letter of the alphabet is represented by a small icon or number.
3. Copy this secret code along the top half of clean sheets of paper depending on the number of children participating in the activity.
4. On the bottom half, recreate the Bible verse in secret code and underneath each number or icon provide a small space for the children to write down their answer.
5. Hand the papers out to the children and impose a generous time limit for them to “break the secret code”. Children will love this activity.
6. Move on to the next Bible verse.

Name of Scripture Memorization Technique:

Shine! Scripture Memorization Technique

Description:

Memorizing the Bible verse is useless if your child is unable to retain the words in his or her memory after long periods of time. Reviewing is just as important as memorization. This technique helps your child and his or her friends retain the Bible verses that they have already memorized.

Methodology:

1. Ask the children to stand around in a circle in the middle of the room.
2. Tell everyone to listen as you say the Scripture reference of a Bible verse they've recently memorized.
3. Then tap a child on the shoulder to begin the game. That child says the first word of the Bible verse, and then the next child the second word, proceeding in counter-clockwise fashion.
4. If a child is unable to remember a word, he or she sits down and is taken out of the game. The game continues on with the next child.
5. The child saying the final word of the verse must then walk into the middle of the circle and say "Shine!" He or she is considered a winner and gets to sit out and spectate the next game.
6. Move on to the next Bible verse to review.

Name of Scripture Memorization Technique:

Word Scramble Scripture Memorization Game

Description:

This technique puts a Biblical twist on one of the most popular children's game of all time.

Methodology:

1. Choose a simple verse from the Bible your child can relate to.
2. Get several pieces of index cards and write down a single word from the verse on each of them until you've completed the entire verse.
3. Scramble the cards and ask your child to arrange them in their proper order. Use the Scripture reference as a clue.
4. Children love games like these. When your child has successfully put the pieces back in order, reward him or her with a simple treat for memorizing the Scripture.

Name of Scripture Memorization Technique:

Around The Dinner Table Memorization Technique

Description:

This technique requires the whole family to help out, which is a good thing for everyone looking to memorize the Bible verses along with the little one.

Methodology:

1. Choose a simple verse from the Bible, preferably one that's medium-length, not too long and not too short.
2. Divide the number of words in the verse by the number of family members. Assign the phrases to each family member, which should be easy to memorize given their short length.
3. At the dinner table, ask the person who memorized the beginning of the verse to stand up and recite his part of the Bible verse preferably with gestures and motions while everybody spectates.
4. Then this person sits down and the next family member stands up, and so on and so forth. Make sure your child is part of this activity. This way, your child will learn his or her Bible verses quickly since it is a shared activity within the entire family, who gets to learn the Bible verses as well.
5. Move on to the next Bible verse and repeat the above procedure.

Afterword

We hope that with these 30 fun-filled techniques, you were able to pass on to your child the importance of preserving the Christian way and the memorization of the God's Word.

As a Christian parent, there is no better feeling than knowing your child has inherited the Bible verses in both heart and mind.
