On November 20, 1968, Mr. Ivan Ceasar, Apartment 2B, 28 West 132nd Street, New York City, New York, superintendent for that apartment building, advised a Special Agent of the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) that Ernest Timothy McGhee was residing at that address in Apartment 3E and had no full time employment.

Assistant United States Attorney Paul M. Rosenberg, Baltimore, Maryland, advised on October 29, 1968, that Ernest Timothy McGhee, also known as Hamaas Khaalis, had been charged with a violation of Title 18, Section 2875, 1942 and 2113 of the United States Code, the Federal Bank Robbery Statutes, and that the facts of this case had been presented to the Federal Grand Jury, Baltimore, Maryland, on October 29, 1968, with this Federal Grand Jury returning a true bill of indictment.

On November 15, 1968, McGhee entered a plea of not guilty to the above mentioned charges. He was released on bond and granted permission to reside in New York, New York.

Assistant United States Attorney Rosenberg advised on January 10, 1969, that he had made tentative arrangements with four New York psychiatrists to give a psychiatric examination to McGhee. Rosenberg was also in correspondence with the legal counsel for McGhee for the purpose of having this counsel choose one of these psychiatrists to conduct the examination. In the meantime prosecutive action against McGhee is being held in abeyance pending the outcome of the psychiatric examination.

McGhee was interviewed at his residence, 35-24 98th Street, Corona, New York, on August 17, 1959, by Special Agents of the FBI at which time McGhee admitted having been a member of

the Nation of Islam (NOI) and the Fruit of Islam (FOI) in the past. He stated he was no longer a member of these organizations but he would "think less of himself as a man if he discussed anything concerning either his activities or associates in the NOI or FOI."

The NOI and the FOI are described

APPENDIX

NATION OF ISLAM, Formerly referred to as the Muslim Cult of Islam, also known as Muhammad's Temples of Islam

In January, 1957, a source advised ELIJAH MUHAMMAD has described his organization on a nationwide basis as the "Nation of Islam" and "Muhammad's Temples of Islam."

On May 5, 1967, a second source advised ELIJAH MUHAMMAD is the national leader of the Nation of Islam (NOI); Muhammad's Temple of Islam No. 2, 5335 South Greenwood Avenue, Chicago, Illinois, is the national headquarters of the NOI; and in mid-1960 MUHAMMAD and other NOI officials, when referring to MUHAMMAD's organization on a nationwide basis, commenced using either "Mosque" or "Temple" when mentioning one of "Muhammad's Temples of Islam."

The NOI is an all-Negro organization which was originally organized in 1930 in Detroit, Michigan. MUHAMMAD claims to have been selected by Allah, the Supreme Being, to lead the so-called Negro race out of slavery in the wilderness of North America by establishing an independent black nation in the United States. Members following MUHAMMAD's teachings and his interpretation of the "Koran" believe there is no such thing as a Negro; that the so-called Negroes are slaves of the white race, referred to as "white devils," in the United States; and that the white race, because of its exploitation of the so-called Negroes, must and will be destroyed in the approaching "War of Armageddon."

In the past, officials and members of the NOI, including MUHAMMAD, have refused to register under the provisions of the Selective Service Acts and have declared that members owe no allegiance to the United States.

On May 5, 1968, the first source advised MUHAMMAD had, upon advice of legal counsel, tempered his personal statements and instructions to his ministers concerning the principles of his organization in order to avoid possible prosecution by the United States government; however, he did not indicate any fundamental changes in the teachings of his organization.

On May 2, 1966, a third source advised MUHAMMAD had, early in July, 1958, decided to de-emphasize the religious aspects of the teachings of Islam and to stress the conomic benefits to be derived by those Negroes who joined the NOI. This policy change, according to MUHAMMAD, would help him acquire additional followers and create more interest in his programs.

APPENDIX

FRUIT OF ISLAM

On May 5, 1967, a source advised that the Fruit of Islam (FOI) is a group within the Nation of Islam (NOI) composed of male members of the NOI. The purpose of the FOI is to protect officials and property of the NOI, assure compliance of members with NOI teachings, and to prepare for the "War of Armageddon." Members of the FOI are required to participate in military drill and are afforded the opportunity to engage in judo training. The FOI is governed by a military system wherein the members are controlled by general orders similar to those issued by regular military organizations.

This investigation was instituted at the request of Earl J. Silbert, U.S. Attorney (USA), U.S. Department of Justice, Washington, D.C. (WDC), based on information that the Hanafi Muslim Sect is or may be involved in activities which involved or will involve the use of force or violence, which would result in the violation of a Federal statute. Members of the Hanafi Muslim Sect were identified in the seizure of three buildings between March 9, 1977 and March 11, 1977, in WDC, wherein violent crime was committed against local citizens and Government and private institutions. Ernest Timothy McGhee, also known as Hamaas Abdul Khaalis, leader of the WDC Hanafi Muslim Sect, recently made public statements advocating the desire of committing various hideous acts against American citizens, and private and Government institutions, which he considers to be responsible for past irreconcilable incidents against his religious sect and family.

Ernest Timothy Mc Ghee was among the individuals arrested in the above-mentioned seizure of three buildings and the hostage incident.

Summary Appraisal (Through 1973)

Subject's personal outlook since 1944 has been consistently marked by antagonism, based on feelings of

isolation, discrimination, and persecution which he has equally consistently expressed. Early in his life, this was evidenced by considerable anti-white, anti-establishment declarations, apparently culminating in his embracal of the NOI and its then virulently separatist policies and acceptance of militant violence. Factionalism, favoritism, and demagoguery within the NOI, by subject's own admission, persuaded him that the NOI was wrong.

With his acceptance of orthodox Islamism, his antagonism has seemed to be focussed on the non-orthodox and the, in his eyes, detractors of orthodoxy. Orthodox Islam demands complete racial tolerance, and subject has preached this, although his practice of it in reality has been less than ideal. When his open antagonism has not been directed at religious differences, it takes on racial tones. This has been especially apparent in his speaking personally about himself, and less apparent when he speaks of and for his religious movement.

Recently (prior to 1973 when investigation was terminated), subject has expressed extreme bias against the NOI and its members, black civil rights activists, the varied black nationalist movements, and Jews. He requires strict obedience of the law amongst his followers, promotes behavior based on civility, and acceptance of the U.S. as home. (Again, speaking of recent history up to and including 1973). Personally, his ideals break down when he speaks of and for himself as an individual.

Subject has historically been preoccupied with the conception of violence, but for strictly delineated purposes of self-defense, religious integrity and justice, as he sees it in his own eyes.

ERNEST TIMOTHY MC GHEE

Criminal Activity

On March 11, 1977, Ernest Timothy Mc Ghee, aka Hamaas Abdul Khaalis, was arrested by the Metropolitan Police Department, Washington, D.C. He was charged with armed kidnapping stemming from his participation along with eleven (11) other members of the Hanafi Muslim Sect (HMS), Washington, D.C., in the armed seizure of three buildings in Washington, D.C., and holding numerous hostages.

On March 31, 1977, HAMAAS ABDUL KHAALIS appeared before Chief Judge HAROLD GREEN, Superior Court, Washington, D.C. (WDC), for a preliminary hearing. At that time, a motion was made by the U.S. Attorney, WDC, for revocation of the personal recognizance of KHAALIS, based on information provided by WFO through a Title III operation. The affidavit in support of the arrest for KHAALIS was sworn to by a WFO Special Agent, Affiant, in which the document contained information as a result of a wire interception.

Chief Judge GREEN revoked the personal bond of KHAALIS and remanded him to the custody of the U.S. Marshals Office, without bond.

ERNEST TIMOTHY MC GHEE

On May 4, 1977, Assistant United States Attorney (AUSA) Mark H. Tuohy, III, Superior Court, WDC, advised that on May 3, 1977, a Federal Grand Jury, WDC, returned a 32 count indictment against Ernest Timothy Mc Ghee, aka Hamaas Abdul Khaalis in connection with his participation in the takeover of three buildings in WDC and holding approximately 135 hostages in March, 1977. The indictment charged Mc Ghee with violation of Title 22, D.C. Code 105a, 2401; 2403; 3202; 501, 3202; 502; 2101, 3202 (Conspiracy; First Degree Murder-Killing While Perpetrating the Crime of Kidnapping Armed; Second Degree Murder While Armed; Assault With Intent To Kill While Armed; Assault With A Dangerous Weapon; Kidnapping While Armed).

On May 10, 1977, AUSA Tuohy advised that Mc Ghee pled not guilty to the above-mentioned charges. Mc Ghee is currently incarcerated in WDC in lieu of posting bond. McGhee's trial is scheduled to begin on May 31, 1977.

ERNEST TIMOTHY MC GHEE, also known as HAMAAS ABDUL KHAALIS, was arrested in Washington, D.C. (WDC), on June 9, 1967, in a bank robbery case involving telephonic threats against bank officials to extort bank funds. He was indicted at Baltimore, Maryland, by a Federal Grand Jury on October 29, 1968, for violation of Title 18, U.S. Code, Section 2875, 1942, and 2113. He entered a plea of Not Guilty on November 15, 1968. Indictment was dismissed on December 10, 1970.

ERNEST TIMOTHY MC GHEE was interviewed by Special Agents of the FBI on August 17, 1959, at which time he admitted his past membership in the Nation of Islam (NOI) and the Fruit of Islam (FOI). He stated he resigned from the NOI in September, 1958, due to the "arrogance and deceitfulness of the National Captain of the FOI; the family oligarchy established by ELIJAH MUHAMMED, and the Gestapo tactics of the NOI Temple officers in Chicago."

(See attached appendix for characterization of the NOI.)

In April, 1966, HAMAAS KHAALIS appeared at the New York Field Office of the U.S. Department of State, and inquired about renouncing his United States citizenship and traveling to Red China with wife and children. He advised his given name was ERNEST TIMOTHY MC GHEE, and was accompanied by his wife, KHADYJA, sons DAUD and RAHMAN UDDEIN, ages 18 and 4; and daughters AMINA and MARYANN, ages 15 and 6. He advised he was instructor and member of the Hanafi Mussulman Religion, and planned to continue his efforts to teach the Hanafi Mussulman Religion in Red China, if he elected to go there. When asked if he would be critical of the United States in the event he went to China, he stated he would be as critical of the United States as it was critical of him.

The March 10, 1977, page A-1 edition of "The Washington Post" newspaper, advised that KHAALIS stated "We will fight to the death...I say, throughout this country, it can get worse, and there is nothing nobody can do about it."

The article continued and quoted an individual by the name of HOFFMAN as saying, "They had big, huge swords. They kept saying they were gonna cut people's heads off...They all said they were going to die, they were going to die for a cause."

The above article was published in the Washington, D.C. metropolitan area at the time 12 members of the Hanafi Muslim Sect held approximately 134 hostages at three locations in Washington, D.C.

On March 10, 1977, page A-1 edition of the "Washington Star-News," in an article, quoted ABDUL AZIZ as follows: "We want them brought to justice, and justice, in this case, is by way of the sword. So if these people aren't delivered, their stand-ins or someone else has to die for it."

According to "The Washington Post," March 11, 1977, page A-11, KHAALIS stated, "ALLAH permits Muslims agressed... to take retribution. ALLAH orders it in the Koran. Retribution is allowed when you are fighting in a war. We are fighting in a war. In a war, innocent civilians are killed...ALLAH says there is no justice without the sword."

This same article quoted AZIZ as stating, "ALLAH tells you that by the way of the Holy Koran, when you are persecuted, you retaliate...it's a war against...the enemies of Islam..."

The article continued by quoting KHADYJA KHAALIS, wife of HAMAAS KHAALIS, as having stated, "It's not just HAMAAS, it's the whole family that's involved. We are all involved, and we are ready to fight to the death also in this house. And if it means us fighting to the death also, so be it, babies and all."

On October 16, 1972, WF T-1 obtained a pocket-sized booklet titled "Look and See," which identifies the author as HAMAAS ABDUL KHAALIS, and is documented as published for the "Hanafi Madh-hab Center, Islam Faith, United States of America, American Mussulmans Headquarters, ASEMI, 7700 16th Street, Northwest, WDC."

The 113 page booklet described the Hanafi Mussulmans as a "Standard of Mankind; a standard in practice and in living an upright life." It states in part that "Hanafi has many meanings," that Hanafi means "the pure, the clean through, upright, those who fear to the death only Allah; it is unswerving, not deviating, not innovating from the Way of the Prophet's Side."

Review of the booklet by a representative of the FBI disclosed it continues throughout in a religious vein, including phrases and verse, in a rambling style, referring frequently to "Mussulman" synonymously with "Muslim." The booklet appears to be directed for the benefit of Asian, African, and Arabian people, but it calls upon the betterment of America as its goal, and proclaims its allegiance to the United States. The booklet makes no reference to the collection or maintenance of weapons, nor any call for violent activity.

WF T-1 advised on November 17, 1972, that meetings are held each Sunday afternoon at the Hanafi American Mussulmans Headquarters, 7700 16th Street, N.W., Washington, D.C. (WDC). The meetings appear to be limited to members of the organization and those attending by invitation of a member. WF T-1 was in a position to state that one such meeting was attended by approximately ten males and seven females; another meeting by approximately six males and three females. The following additional information was obtained by WF T-1 concerning the Hanafi American Mussulmans Organization:

HAMAAS ABDUL KHAALIS is the leader of the Mussulmans Organization and appears to the above source to

be mentally unstable. He claims to have known personally all Presidents of the United States since HARRY S. TRUMAN, and states he was able to foresee, in 1963, the death of President JOHN F. KENNEDY; that he had conversations with the mother of KENNEDY's assassin, LEE HARVEY OSWALD, and believes the KENNEDY assassination was a Jewish plot. WF T- had once heard KHAALIS stated the Hanafi Mussulman organization is anti-semitic, but no specific references to indicate the basis for the anti-semitic position.

KHAALIS has been known to state a "true Muslim" can foresee certain things; claiming he had been foretold that SONNY LISTON would die prior to the death of the former heavyweight boxer.

KHAALIS claims the Islam advanced by the Mussulmans Organization is the true Islam, which came originally from India, and although not a prophet of ALLAH, he has been chosen to teach the true Islam. According to KHAALIS, the true Mussulman teaches love and not the ideology of other black groups such as ELIJAH MUHAMMED, leader of the Nation of Islam (NOI), or MALCOLM X. KHAALIS has been known to state in the past his organization disdains the civil rights movement, and he has been heard to refer to prominent past civil rights proponents as "Martin Luther Coon" and "Ralph Abernasty," and to classify blacks who preach the Pan-African concept as "bushy hairs." KHAALIS in his writings and his oral statements, has proclaimed the United States as the home of the Mussulman, not Africa.

Concerning the Hanafi Rifle and Pistol Club, WF T- learned the club has been in the formative stage for several months and recently obtained some sort of charter. KHAALIS has been heard to state classes in karate and self-defense were also going to be taught, and this was all necessary to be able to "deal" with the "bushy hairs" if the occasion should arise. He claims plans to recruit 20,000 members for the rifle and pistol club.

WF T- advised people use the Juniper Street side door to enter and exit the premises at 7700 16th Street, N.W. A sign is on display in the hallway ordering no smoking,

no narcotics, nor dangerous weapons. Individuals entering are usually searched. The living room on the ground floor facing 16th Street is used for prayer and other meetings, those entering being required to remove their shoes. Small mattresses are on the floor and are utilized for sitting during the meetings. The living room wall is decorated with several different kinds of machetes and swords. There is no indication of any target or storage area for weapons on the first floor.

KHAALIS has never been heard to advocate any acts of violence except for self defense. He has never urged for confrontation with police, and to the contrary, has instructed that no true Muslim would violate the law.

Investigation conducted as November 15, 1972, including the observations of WF T- and other confidential sources, has developed no information to indicate LEW ALCINDOR (KAREEN ABDUL JABBAR) is actively affiliated with the Hanafi Mussulmans Organization in WDC.

CURRENT HMS ACTIVITIES

On April 21, 1977, WF T-2 made available the attached letter which was being distributed in the Washington, D.C., Metropolitan area by members of HMS. The letter indicates Abdul Khaalis had prepared its contents.

During March and April, 1977, sources in WDC and other areas of the United States were canvassed regarding Mc Ghee and they could not provide any positive information concerning him.

NATION OF ISLAM (NOI)
CHARACTERIZATION OF SUBVERSIVE ORGANIZATION
EXTREMIST MATTER

The Nation of Islam (NOI) is a black nationwide organization headquartered at Muhammad's Temple #2, 7351 South Stony Island Avenue, Chicago, Illinois. Elijah Muhammad, self-styled "Messenger of Allah" and divinely appointed leader of the black race in America, was leader of the NOI until his death on February 25, 1975, at which time his son, Wallace D. Muhammad, became Supreme Minister of the NOI. The NOI seeks a separate black nation, espouses its own version of the Islamic Religion, and has considered all "whites" to be devils; however, Wallace D. Muhammad in an interview published in "Muhammad Speaks," March 21, 1975, same being a weekly and the official NOI newspaper, stated there would no longer be stress put on the white people's status as "devils;" that whites have "begun to reform" and "The past is the past until it is dug up. We will not dig it up." NOI official policy instructs members to obey laws of the United States that do not conflict with NOI laws; to defend NOI officials, property, women, and themselves at all costs, if attacked; and to disarm any attacker and use the attacker's weapon against him.

The NOI body is broken down into: 1) the Fruit of Islam (FOI), an all male military-type group, to which instruction in judo and karate is given, and which has as its mission security of officials, membership and property of the NOI, and enforcing discipline in the NOI; and 2) the Muslim Girls Training (MGT), an all female quasi military-type group which has as its mission home-making and child guidance in accordance with NOI teachings.

NOI activity is widespread among black inmates in many prisons in the United States. In recent years internal dissidence and difficulties with rival Muslim groups and other adversaries have produced considerable violence, some involving physical confrontations and acts of violence with law enforcement agencies.

This full domestic security investigation was instituted at the instructions of FBI Headquarters on March 18, 1977, based on information indicating Ernest Timothy Mc Ghee, aka, Hamas Abdul Khaalis, publicly identified as the leader of the Hanafi Muslim Sect (HMS), Washington, D.C., is or may be involved in activities which involve or will involve the use of force or violence and which involve or will involve the violation of Federal law for the purpose of substantially impairing for the purpose of influencing U.S. policies or decisions: (a) the functioning of the Government of the United States, and (b) interstate commerce.

The Nation of Islam (NOI) is a black nationwide organization headquartered at Muhammad's Temple #2, 7351 South Stony Island Avenue, Chicago, Illinois. Elijah Muhammad, self-styled "Messenger of Allah" and divinely appointed leader of the black race in America, was leader of the NOI until his death on February 25, 1975, at which time his son, Wallace D. Muhammad, became Supreme Minister of the NOI. The NOI seeks a separate black nation, espouses its own version of the Islamic Religion, and has considered all "whites" to be devils; however, Wallace D. Muhammad in an interview published in "Muhammad Speaks," March 21, 1975, same being

a weekly and the official NOI newspaper, stated there would no longer be stress put on the white people's status as "devils;" that white have "begun to reform" and "The past is the past until it is dug up. We will not dig it up." NOI official policy instructs members to obey laws of the United States that do not conflict with NOI laws; to defend NOI officials, property, women, and themselves at all costs, if attacked; and to disarm any attacker and use the attacker's weapon against him.

The NOI body is broken down into: 1) the Fruit of Islam (FOI), an all male military-type group, to which instruction in judo and karate is given, and which has as its mission security of officials, membership and property of the NOI, and enforcing discipline in the NOI; and 2) the Muslim Girls Training (MGT), and all female quasi military-type group which has as its mission homemaking and child guidance in accordance with NOI teachings.

NOI activity is widespread among black inmates in many prisons in the United States. In recent years internal dissidence and difficulties with rival Muslim groups and other adversaries have produced considerable violence, some involving physical confrontations and acts of violence with law enforcement agencies.

Ernest Timothy McGhee, Negro, male, was born on August 30, 1922, at Gary, Indiana. He is married and resides at 7700 16th Street, N.W., Washington, D.C. (WDC). McGhee is the self-proclaimed spiritual leader of Hanafi Muslim Sect (HMS) headquartered at his residence. He has been self-employed for the past several years, but held previous employments in Chicago, Indiana and New York.

McGhee served in the U.S. Army, where he was found insane in 1944, suffering from "psychosis-dementia praecox-paranoid" and received a disability discharge. Since his discharge from the military, he has been examined by the Veterans Administration (VA) on numerous occasions and his VA claims were continued.

In 1949, McGhee signed a Communist Party Petition in New York City (NYC) in 1951 he joined the Nation of Islam (NOI) in NYC and later became Secretary of the NOI in Chicago and subsequently resigned from the NOI in 1958.

after a dispute with the group's Administration.

In 1972, he founded EMS, also known as Hanafi
 Madh-hab Center, Islam Faith, United States of America-
 America Mussulmans and the Hanafi American Mussulmans Rifle
 and Pistol Club, 7700 16th Street, N.W., Washington, D.C.
 Seven (7) members of McGhee's family were murdered in 1973
 at EMS headquarters. As leader of EMS McGhee preached the
 Orthodox Islamic forth.

McGhee claims the Islam advanced by the Mussulmans
 Organization is the true Islam which came originally from
 India, and although he (McGhee) is not a prophet of Allah,
 he has been chosen to teach the true Islam. The true
 Mussulman teaches love. Hanafi Rifle and Pistol Club held
 classes in karate and self-defense in order to "deal"
 with the "bushy hairs" if the occasion should arise. McGhee
 stated, "Allah permits Muslims aggressed...to take retribution...
 Allah says there is no justice with the sword."

Credit and Civil Service Commission checks con-
 cerning McGhee were made with negative results.

McGhee was arrested in 1967 in a bank robbery
 case in Washington, D.C., involving telephonic threats
 against family of bank official to extort funds, wherein the
 charges was later dismissed.

Twelve EMS members including McGhee were arrested
 on March 11, 1977, by the Metropolitan Police Department (MPD)
 and charged with Armed Kidnapping in the seizure of three
 building in WDC, and holding approximately 145 individuals
 hostage. All participants are currently in jail awaiting
 trial.

At approximately 11:00 a.m., March 9, 1977, five
 gunmen, subsequently identified as being members of the Hanafi
 Muslim Sect (HMS) entered the B'nai B'rith Building, 1640
 Rhode Island Avenue, N.W., WDC, and took approximately 115
 hostages. Two of the hostages were wounded by firearms.

At approximately the same time as the B'nai B'rith
 incident, three gunmen, subsequently identified as being
 members of the HMS, entered the Islamic Center, 2551
 Massachusetts Avenue, N.W., WDC, and took approximately 25

hostages were held.

McGhee, was identified as the spokesman for the
 gunmen who made four demands, which are as follows:

1. That the showing of the movie "Mohammed: Messenger of God" appearing in movie theatres in New York, be stopped.
2. That the \$750 fine levied against McGhee for a contempt of court citation issued by United States District Court, WDC, be returned to his wife.
3. That Cassius Clay (Muhammad Ali) and Wallace I, as well as other individuals believed to be responsible for the 1973 murder of HNS members be brought to Mc Ghee at the B'nai B'rith Building.
4. That the San Francisco killer who lobbed off the head of the blue-eyed and blonde hair" be brought to him.

The March 10, 1977, page A-1 edition of "The Washington Post" newspaper, advised that Khalis stated "We will fight to the death...I say, throughout this country, it can get worse, and there is nothing nobody can do about it."

McGhee has made numerous public and private threats to commit various criminal acts to include, "I'll kill all 200 people today," "Tell them I'll let some of my men go," and "We are going to get the Government for this."

All informants of the Federal Bureau of Investigation were canvassed regarding McGhee without developing any pertinent information. McGhee maintained regular contacts with personnel of the Iranian, Pakistanian, and Egyptian embassies, WDC.

CAUTION

McGhee should be considered armed and extremely dangerous in as much as he is known to possess weapons.
