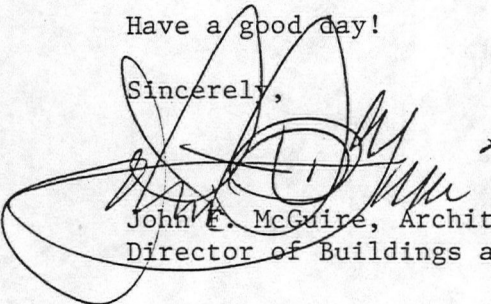
Your letter to Father Fitzpatrick, long past pastor of the subject church, finally made its way into my hands.
