The Ionic tetrastyle portico is pedimented, with an oculus in the center of the pediment, and the name 'Stephens County' is on the entablature. The cross plan of the two story building with basement has corner pavilions that project from a center core. The whole structure has an octagonal ribbed dome with hooded clocks (E. Howard clock) and a lantern. The dome rises from a square base and on the second stage directly under the clocks has arched windows enclosed by coupled pilasters and a pediment. This motif is repeated around the dome and echoes the design of the main facade. Today it still towers over the town and is very near the new downtown shopping mall.

Upstairs, the courtroom's elaborate pressed metal ceiling has been left intact. Designwise, the most impressive feature of this ceiling is a recessed shallow rectangle directly under the exterior dome. Colored glass squares of soft shades of green, yellow, and pink in the transoms of the windows give a muted glow. Modern additions such as comfortable jury chairs, microphones and sound equipment increase the usefulness of the room as a court of law.


