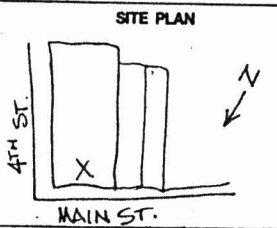






The style should be compared to the Hulman Building of about ten years later in which the older building's architectural formula of "base+column+capital" was abandoned.
