

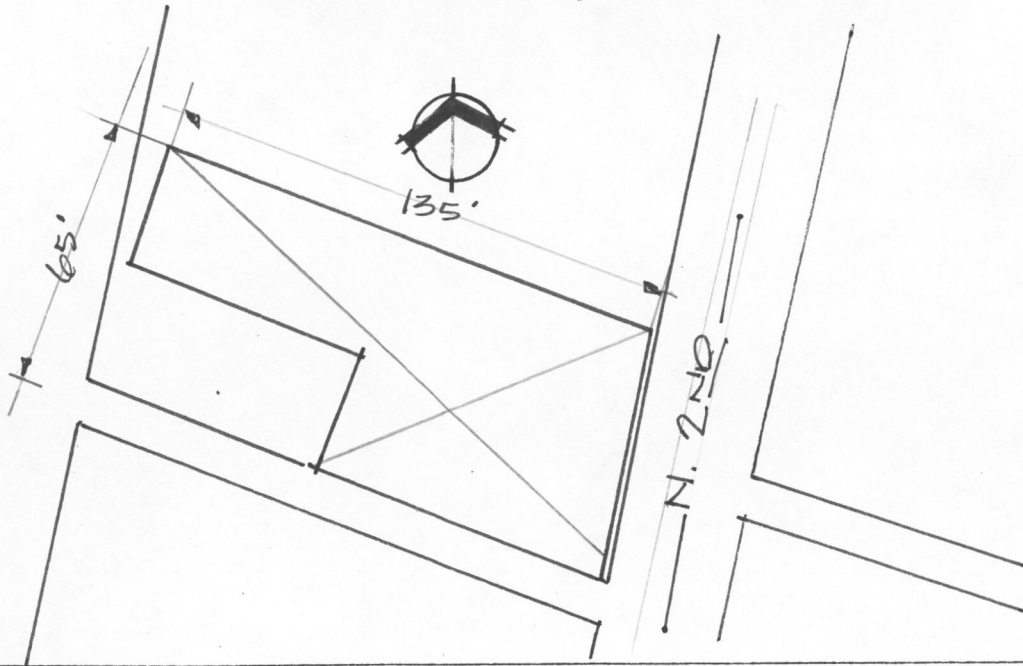

Beginning at a point in the southeast corner of the intersection of Pike and Second Street; travelling south 130 feet to the north corner of the Second Street facade of the Oddfellows Building; then south 65 feet along the east right of way of Second Street to a point; then east 135 feet along the south facade of the Oddfellows building to a point; then turning north 65 feet to a point; then 135 feet west along the north facade of the Oddfellows building to the point of beginning.
