DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (if known) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

Number of stories: The house is three stories high with an attic and a basement.

Number of bays: The house is five bays wide.

Layout and/or shape of plan: The plan of the building is wedge-shaped with wide curved front and truncated rear.

Wall construction: The walls are of brick laid in Flemish bond. The basement is constructed of stuccoed stonework.

Structural system: The structural system is masonry bearing wall.

Roof, cornice: The roof is multi-level with varying pitches. The cornice of wood has modillions and is surmounted by a wood balustrade.

Porches, dormers, chimneys: There is a large curved portico which follows the curve of State Street. At the first floor level the portico has square wood piers and the two stories above have slender unfluted lonic columns. There are several high brick chimneys at the roof.

Important interior features: The front dining room is restored with its original mantel and appropriate Federal detailing.

Other notable features: There are oval windows on the west wall, splayed window lintels with double keystones and rectangular and oval panels of stone set between the windows of the east portion of the house.

Alterations and additions: The west portion of the house was added in 1806 with the large curved portico in front. There were dormers at the roof over the east portion which were removed in 1964.

This recently restored Federal house at 7 State Street was originally built in two parts. The eastern portion is two bays of a larger 5-bay house built in 1793 for James Watson. He later divided his house, selling the easternmost portion to a neighbor. The distinctive colonnaded section to the west was added in 1806 when the house was owned by Moses Rogers. The 1793 house has been attributed to John McComb (1761-1853) who designed another State Street house. and who is best known for his work in connection with the designing of New York's City Hall.

When Moses Rogers decided to extend his house to the west, the bend in State Street posed a problem, which was solved by the curve of the monumental portico. Its colonnade screens the angle of the joining of the two sections of houses and also provides them with a most unusual and arresting feature.

When State Street was laid out near the end of the 18th century. it became a street of impressive residences. Number 7 is the last of the Federal townhouses that once lined the street, and the architect of its 1964-65 restoration called its survival a "near miracle". As restored on the basis of a print from Valentine's Manual of 1859, the house has been returned to its original appearance with its fine cornice, surmounted by a wood balustrade and its handsome triple sash windows at the main floor. An important residence when it was built, its preservation today makes it an extremely rare and important monument of the American Federal period.




