DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The Campbell House is a three story Italianate Villa style building constructed of brick with a stone foundation. The plan is basically T-shaped with a four story tower located in the angle created by the intersecting wings on the facade. Throughout the house, the windows are two-over-two double hung with simple stone sills and lintels except on the third floor where the windows are smaller with a pointed arch. The main entrance is a double paneled door. Three of the facade's five bays, including the entrance, are covered by a flat roofed porch with decoratively carved railing and pillars. The roofs are slate and consist of a combination of gabled and mansard styles. The mansard roof on the tower is surrounded by a wrought-iron railing. There is also a railing on the third floor roof behind the tower which forms a widows-walk. The house is unaltered on the exterior. The interior still has the original marble fireplaces and many of the original gas light fixtures.

The carriage house, located to the west and rear of the house, is a two-story brick building with stone foundation and basement. The carriage house is L-shaped with intersecting slate, gabled roof. A cupola crowns the point of intersection of the two roofs. Windows throughout have rounded arches with molded stone lintels. On the east facade the two, large, square doors have paired rounded arches across the top.

A vintage water tower has a drum-shaped stone base on a square wooden top with gabled roof.

The stables consist of a long, rectangular building with vertically placed boards. The building has a gable roof and two square cupolas.

A frame barn is also located on the property, and has a gambrel roof that continues into a shed roof on the west side. This building is also constructed with vertically placed boards.

## STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

The Hugh Campbell House is an excellent example of mid-nineteenth century Italianate Villa Style architecture. The surrounding farm buildings, also mid-century, combine with the house to create a basically unaltered illustration of rural living at the middle of the century. Surrounded by modern development, the Campbell farm is the only remainder of the once rural area of Harrison.

Hugh Campbell was a native of County Tyrone Ireland. He was born on November 12, 1828. He and his father immigrated to the United States and settled in Philadelphia. From Philadelphia, Hugh Campbell immigrated to New Orleans, where he became a successful contractor of levees. In 1850 he moved to St. Louis where he built the Casenville Coal Railroad, a branch of the O & M Railroad. Finally, in 1852 he moved to Cincinnati and was employed by the firm of Boyle and Locke, Contractors. Eventually he became a partner of Mr. Boyle's. In 1858 he withdrew from the firm and became active in the building of railroads, bridges and sewers. He was employed by Doolittle & Chamberlin, contractors of the Cincinnati, Hamilton and Dayton railroads. He built many of the most important sewers of Cincinnati and numerous bridges, one being the bridge over Whitewater River, near Harrison, which was burned by the Confederate Army during Morgan's Raid. His farm in Harrison originally consisted of 400 acres. Mr. Campbell specialized in the breeding of Jersey and Shorthorn cattle, Oxford-down sheep, and Berkshire hogs. The out-buildings of "Phoenix Park" reflect his success in his architectural pursuits.

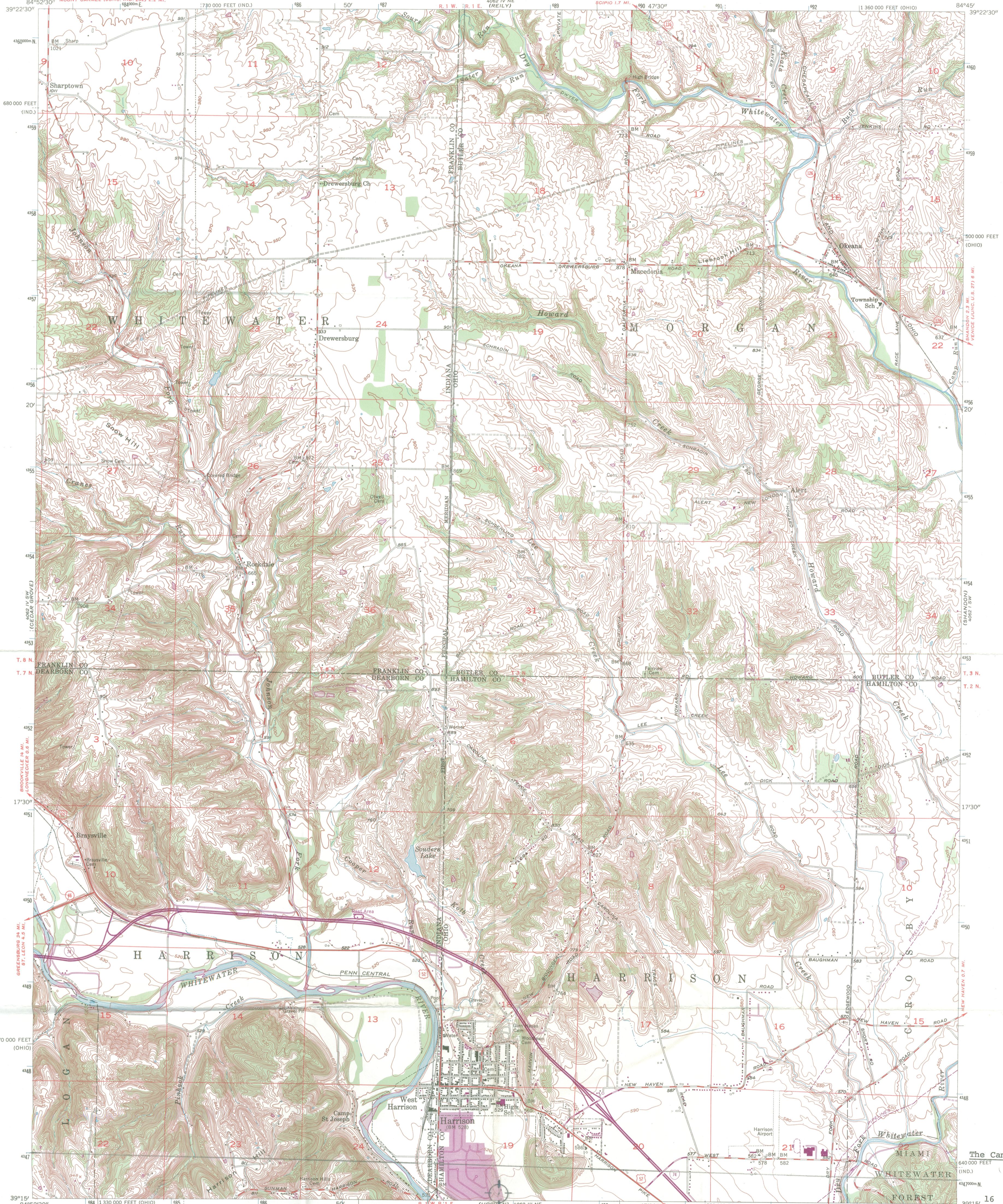

An excellent example of the mid-19th C. Italian Villa - type house, this was the home of Hugh Campbell prominent contractor, and sewer <sup>and</sup> bridge builder.
