## DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The Federal structure of 1838 had a rectangular central hall plan with five bay Flemish bond facade. Around 1850 the house was extensively renovated adding a central advancing wing and bracketed eaves of Victorian influence. There is a frame wing to the right rear that has been considerably renovated but appears to be antique in its origins. A large garage of compatible design has been appended to the frame wing. (1942)

The three bay American bond brick facade has an embrasure Greek Revival entranceway with frontispiece and crisscross framed doorway in the right bay. The windows are 6/6 double hung sash with stone lintels and sills. On the federal transverse block the windows have flat brick arches with radiating voussoirs. The house is unified by eaves and gables with returns having a bracketed box cornice with dentils. The ridged sheet metal roof has inside end two stack bridged chimneys with decorative corbelled courses and caps.

A porch on the left reentrant angle with entablature, terminal pilaster, and balustraded deck has been enclosed for use as an office/study.

The interior has considerable original trim in evidence in both parts including the entrance hall in the "new" wing and Federal work in the basic house.

To the northwest by the highway is the beehive school house. This is a plain rectangular functional brick structure, c. 1846, with a brick foundation. The central door of the three bay facade is rectangular with a large shed roofed hood. The rectangular windows are shuttered and have radiating voussoirs and wood sills. There is a semi-circular brick arched gable window in the west end. The eaves and gables project with facia alone. There is a large chimney inside in the right end.

The Scott Turkey Farm is in a rural setting one mile south of Greenville. There is a vernacular brick smokehouse behind the garage. The other outbuildings of the farm are not historically significant.

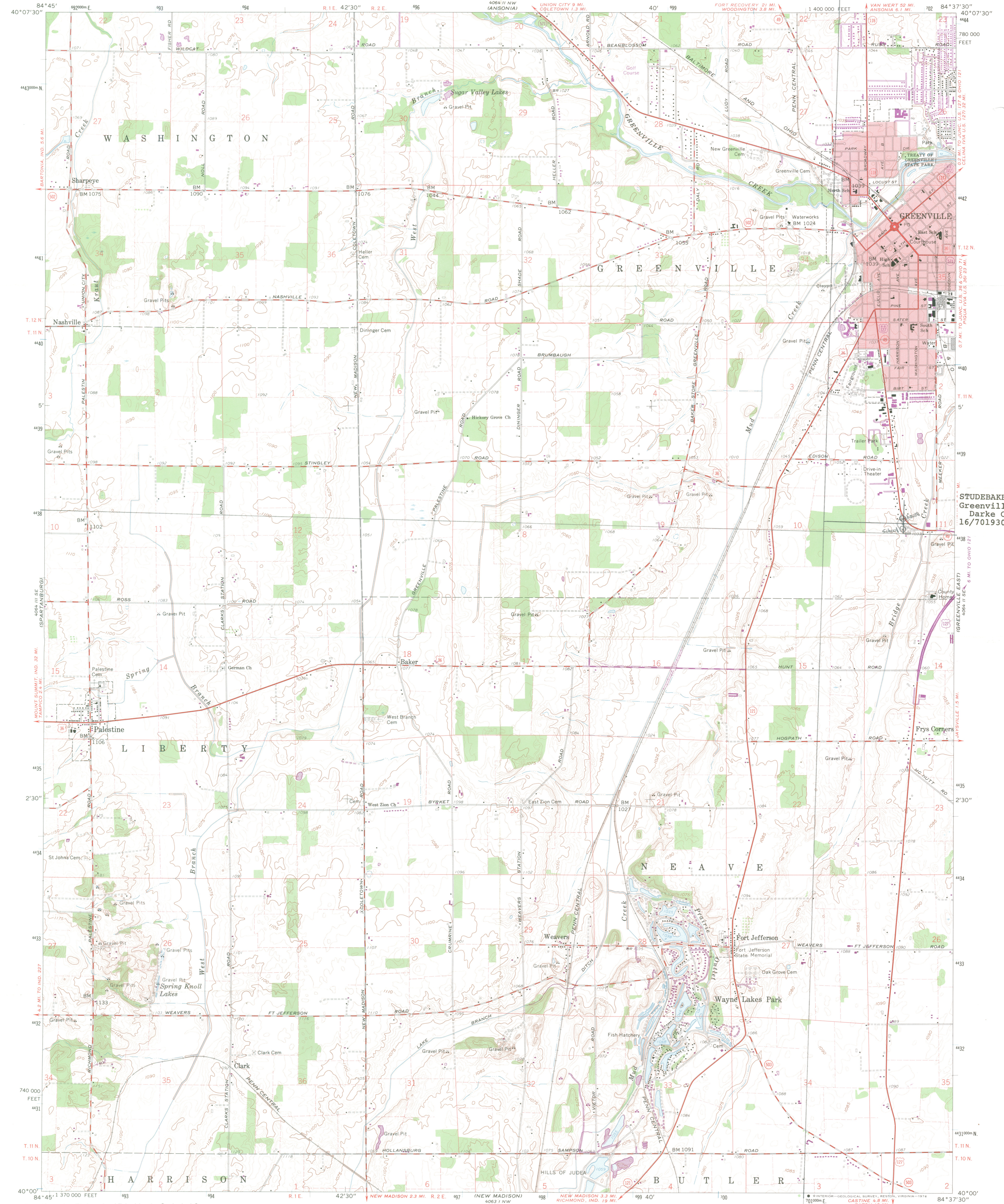

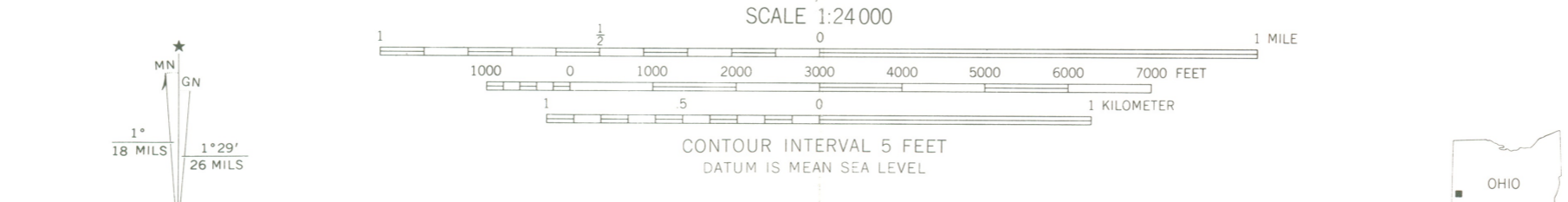
