DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The McDannald Homestead which is located approximately 1/2 mile south of I-270 is one of the largest, best preserved rural residences in Franklin County. Erected C. 1850 it remains relatively unchanged today.

Constructed in brick laid in 5 course American bond, it rests on a stone foundation. This substantial 2 1/2 story farmhouse measures 5 by 4 bays and is crowned with an intersecting gable roof. The one story wing to the north was probably built at the same time as the main house.

The dominant feature of the 5 bay facade is the handsome, recessed entrance. The segmental arch of the 6 panel door is repeated in the curved transom and arched sidelights. A triple row of brick headers surround the arch within the recess and on the plane of the facade.

A double row of brick headers, forming segmental jack arches are employed on the windows and the sills are made stone. The sashes appear to be original. The addition to the north has rectangular 6/6 windows with stone lintels and sills and a small wooden porch.

The fenestration on the remaining elevations of the main house symmetrical and the segmental arched windows are used throughout. The box cornice is bracketed on all elevations.

A late nineteenth century photograph shows curved shutters on all the windows and 4 brick chimneys of which only one remains.

The house is located on a by-passed segment of Old Sunbury Road. It is surrounded by fields and has several outbuildings to the rear.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

The McDannald Homestead is an excellent, well preserved example of mid-19th century rural architecture in Franklin County.

The actual designer is unknown, however, it may have been the work of Randal Arnold, a master craftsman who came to Blendon Township in 1825. Regardless, the house is constructed extremely well. The bricks were fired on the site and local lumber was used for the interior. Although quite large in scale, the sensitive handling of architectural detail contributes to the overall graceful lines of the house.

The parents of John Calvin McDannald, the builder, came to Blendon Township from Virginia in 1813. The McDannalds and their decedents were involved in the formation and growth of Blendon Township, Central College and area churches. It has remained in the McDannald family until recently.

A similar home nearby was demolished during highway construction. The owners of the McDannald Homestead are aware of its architectural significance and are interested in its preservation.
