It is an honor to recommend David L. Huber, of Kentucky, to be United States Attorney for the Western District of Kentucky, for the term of four years, vice Stephen B. Pence, resigned.

Mr. Huber was born (b) (6) is married and has two children. He received a B.A. degree in 1965 from the University of Louisville and a J.D. degree in 1968 from the University of Louisville School of Law. He was admitted to the Kentucky Bar and the U.S. District Court for the Western District of Kentucky in 1968 and the Sixth Circuit Court of Appeals in 1974.

Since January 1991, Mr. Huber has served as an Assistant United States Attorney for the Office of the United States Attorney, Western District of Kentucky. Prior to this position, he was General Counsel to U.S. Senator Mitch McConnell, Washington, D.C., 1990 - 1991; a Vice President and General Counsel for Glenmore Distilleries Company of Louisville, 1987 - 1989; a 2nd Vice President for Capitol Holding Corporation of Louisville, 1985 - 1987; the Chief Administrative Officer for the Jefferson County Fiscal Court of Louisville, 1978 - 1985; an Assistant United States Attorney for the Office of the United States Attorney, Western District of Kentucky, 1972 - 1978; a Legislative Assistant to U.S. Senator Marlow W. Cook, Washington, D.C., 1969 - 1972; and an Attorney with Goldberg & Lloyd of Louisville, 1968 - 1969.

Mr. Huber has an excellent reputation as to character and integrity and possesses the appropriate temperament for this position. I recommend his nomination as a United States Attorney.
