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Biographical Information for William P. Barr

Mr. Barr was nominated by President Bush and confirmed by the Senate as Assistant Attorney General for the Office of Legal Counsel in the Department of Justice. He has been serving in that capacity since April 1989.

Mr. Barr received his BA and MA degrees, in 1971 and 1973 respectively, from Columbia University in New York. He received his JD degree with highest honors in 1977 from George Washington University.

From 1973 to 1977, Mr. Barr served with the Central Intelligence Agency. From 1977 through 1978 he served as law clerk to Judge Malcolm Wilkey of the U.S. Court of Appeals for the District of Columbia Circuit. From 1982 to 1983, Mr. Barr served on the Domestic Policy staff at the White House.

Mr. Barr has been in private practice for nine years, first as an associate (1978-82) and then as a partner (1984-89), with the Washington law firm of Shaw, Pittman, Potts, and Trowbridge. He left the firm in April to serve as Assistant Attorney General. Mr. Barr, his wife Christine, and three children reside in Virginia.
