**COMMANDER JAMES C. HOLLOWAY
UNITED STATES NAVY**

Commander James C. Holloway entered the United States Naval Academy from Colfax, Indiana and graduated in 1973 with a Bachelor of Science Degree in Physics. He completed Nuclear Power Training and reported in October 1974 to USS TAUTOG (SSN 638) where he served in various division officer billets and completed qualification in submarines. Commander Holloway reported in March 1977 to the Naval Nuclear Propulsion Training Unit in Windsor, Connecticut, where he served as an instructor until February 1979.

Commander Holloway assumed duties as the commissioning Engineer Officer on USS LA JOLLA (SSN 701) in February 1979 and served in that billet until June 1982. He next served as Material Officer on the staff of Commander, Submarine Squadron 10 from July 1982 to June 1984.

Commander Holloway attended Prospective Commanding Officer training and then served as the Officer in Charge of Submarine NR-1, the U. S.
