who was both interesting and charming.

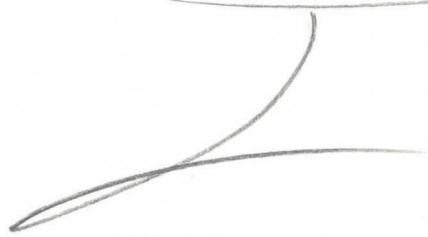
I enjoyed meeting Marilyn Quayle at

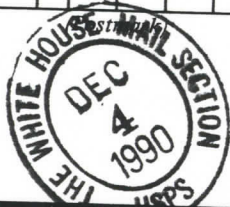

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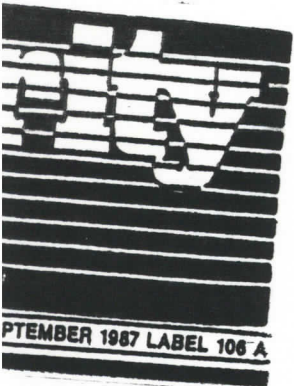

and I know Mark did his too.

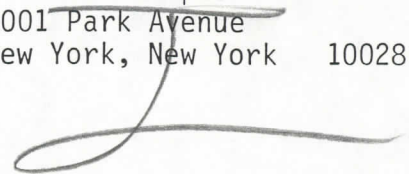
As always we would have liked

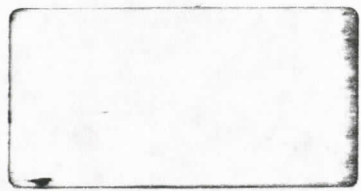
