SUBJECT: Scowcroft Call to Conable at the World Bank

According to the attached communication provided by George Folsom's office at Treasury, Conable is returning late this afternoon.

I think Brent should call him late this afternoon or early tomorrow, at the latest, lest Brent be hit with the old "We have already printed the agenda!" excuse.

As of noon today, Treasury had already obtained commitments from Japan and Canada to vote against approval of the transport project loan. However, State believes that a Scowcroft-Conable call is still required to break the back of what is a conscious World Bank policy to normalize all lending policies toward China thereby allowing the Bank to put through loans totalling \$1 billion by the end of the fiscal year.

2000-1204-F (Talking Points for NSA Scowcroft's telephone call to Conable)

Issue

- The U.S. strongly desires that the Jiangsu Provincial Transport project (IBRD/IDA \$150 million) be pulled from the Board's agenda for Tuesday, March 20. It can be replaced by another loan meeting BHN criteria, such as Vocational and Technical Education (IDA).
- This project clearly does not meet basic human needs (BHN), as its primary components are the modernization of transportation infrastructure between Nanjing and Shanghai.
- (b)(1)
- If this project is not withdrawn, the U.S. will naturally oppose it in conformity with our existing human rights legislation.
- Additionally, we will seek to have other G-7 nations oppose this project.
- Finally, Bank approval of the first clearly non-BHN project since Tiananmen Square will have very negative Congressional consequences for the Bank. Chairman Obey issued a clear warning yesterday to our IDA request.
- FYI: Representative Obey said: "World Bank lending to China would be an act of extreme unfortunate judgement if lending goes beyond BHN. If the Administration is interested in IDA funding (\$1.06 billion for FY 1991), it will be an impossible event if normal lending is resumed to China."
