

The President's Council of Science and Technology Advisors was established January 19, 1990 by Executive Order 12700 for the purpose of providing high-level advice directly to the President on a wide range of important issues concerning science and technology.

II. Term

Members serve at the pleasure of the President.

The Council shall be composed of not more than 15 members, 14 of which shall be distinguished individuals from the private sector to be appointed by the President.

Dr. Mary L. Good

Mary L. Good is Senior Vice President - Technology for Allied-Signal Inc. Her career spans both academic and industrial scientific research and she plays a continuing role in science policy-making at the national level. As chairman of the National Science Board, she leads the policy-making body for the National Science Foundation, whose mission is to promote science education and support much of this country's research in basic science. In 1987 as president of the American Chemical Society, Dr. Good convened the Select Conference on Advances in Biotechnology and Materials Science in Washington, D.C. for representatives of the press, financial and governmental communities who make and interpret science policy.

After receiving the Ph.D. in Inorganic Chemistry from the University of Arkansas at Fayetteville, Dr. Good taught chemistry and materials science for more than 25 years within the Louisiana State University system. During her tenure there, she was named Boyd Professor of Chemistry and later, Boyd Professor of Materials Science.

Dr. Good came to industry in 1980 as director of research at UOP, a company well-known for its oil processing technology, now jointly owned by Allied-Signal Inc. and Union Carbide. As president of the former UOP research center, Dr. Good broadened and deepened the company's research capabilities, developing major programs in materials science, biotechnology, separations science and materials-by-design. Now, as Senior Vice President-Technology, Dr. Good oversees Allied-Signal's Research & Technology organization, including laboratories in New Jersey, Illinois and New York.

Dr. Good is a member of the National Academy of Engineering as well as several National Academy of Sciences panels and government advisory committees. She is a past president of the Inorganic Division of the International Union of Pure and Applied Chemistry and a past president of the American Chemical Society, the world's largest scientific professional organization.
