private sector appointed by the President.

CHAIRMAN: Director of the Office of Science and Technology
Policy

VICE CHAIRMAN: Appointed by the President from among the 14
private sector members.

TERM: Pleasure of the President

SALARY: Without compensation; however, members appointed
from among private citizens of the United States
may be allowed travel expenses, including per diem
in lieu of subsistence, as authorized by law for
persons serving intermittently in the Government
service (5 U.S.C. 5701-5707).

PURPOSE: The Council shall advise the President on matters
involving all areas of science and technology. In
the performance of its advisory duties the Council
shall conduct a continuing review and assessment
of developments in science and technology, and
shall, through the Chairman, report thereon to the
President whenever requested.

TERMINATION: The Council shall terminate on June 30, 1991,
unless sooner extended.

SUBJECT: Conflict-of-Interest Standards

Congratulations on your appointment to serve as a member of the President's Council of Science and Technology Advisors.

Attached for your records is a copy of the conflict-of-interest waiver that I have signed at Dr. Bromley's request. The waiver certifies that the government's need for your services outweighs certain aspects of the conflict-of-interest that may otherwise exist by virtue of your employment and other financial interests. This determination has the effect of a partial exemption from the restrictions imposed by 18 U.S.C. 208, the general financial conflict-of-interest statute. Please note that you are still required to recuse yourself should any matter arise that would directly and predictably affect any of your financial interests in a unique manner -- as opposed to matters having a broad effect across an industry.

A general memorandum describing federal conflict-of-interest laws is attached for your reference. Additional advice on ethics matters is available to you from Michelle Van Cleave, Counsel and Designated Agency Ethics Official for the Office of Science and Technology Policy.

The President today announced his intention to nominate Thomas Joseph Murrin to be Deputy Secretary of Commerce. He would succeed Donna F. Tuttle.

Mr. Murrin was President of Westinghouse Energy and Advance Technology Group, 1983-1987. From 1952 until 1987, he served in various capacities for Westinghouse Electric Corporation: President of the Public Systems Company, 1974; Senior Vice President of the Public Systems Group, 1974; Executive Vice President of the Defense and Public Systems Group, 1971; Group Vice President of Defense, 1967; Corporate Vice President of Manufacturing, 1965. In 1959, he was appointed European Manufacturing Representative based in Geneva, Switzerland; and was Superintendent of Factory Planning for the new Distribution Transformer plant in Athens, Georgia, in 1955. He joined the Carnegie Mellon University as Distinguished Service Professor in Technology and Management.

Mr. Murrin was graduated from Fordham University (B.S., 1951). He is married, has eight children and resides in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania.

THOMAS J. MURRIN

In December 1990, Thomas J. Murrin was named dean of Duquesne University's School of Business and Administration; effective January 1, 1991---after serving for 18 months as deputy secretary of the U. S. Department of Commerce; nominated by President George Bush on May 22, 1989 and confirmed by the U. S. Senate on June 21, 1989.

At the Department of Commerce---with its approximately 40,000 people and an annual budget of about \$3 billion---Murrin was deeply involved in a variety of executive activities including the 1990 Decennial Census; the Malcolm Baldrige National Quality Award; the Modernization of the National Weather Service; the new Advanced Technology Program; oversight of the Patent and Trademark Office; and---through the International Trade Administration and the Export Administration ---important relations with dozens of nations around the world.

As "Acting Secretary" for Commerce Secretary Mosbacher, Murrin attended Cabinet and other top level meetings with President Bush, Vice President Quayle or other senior Federal Government executives.

In addition, Murrin was appointed by President Bush to chair the new Commission on the Federal Appointment Process; was selected to chair the Federal Quality Institute; was appointed chair of the new Interagency Committee on Technology and Industry by the President's Science and Technology Advisor, Dr. Allan Bromley; and became a member of the NASA Advisory Council at the invitation of the Administrator of NASA, (Ret.) Admiral Richard Truly.

Recruited to the Westinghouse Electric Corporation as a graduate student in 1951, Murrin initially worked as a manufacturing/materials engineer. Over the next 36 years, he served in various positions with Westinghouse---including Corporate European Manufacturing Representative based in Geneva, Switzerland; corporate vice president of Manufacturing; senior vice president of the Defense and Public Systems Group; and president of the Public Systems Company.

Murrin retired in 1987 as president of the firm's Energy and Advanced Technology Group---an organization with nearly \$5 billion in annual sales. In that capacity from 1983 through 1987, Murrin was responsible for Westinghouse's worldwide operations in defense and aerospace systems; electric energy systems; and people-moving systems. He was a member of the Westinghouse Management Committee---the top policy-making body of the corporation---from 1974 until his retirement. Quality and productivity improvement were elevated as key corporate concerns under his guidance.

Building on his extensive foreign travel and study of industrial operations overseas---most notably in Japan--- Murrin served as a U. S. delegate to the NATO Industrial Advisory Group; headquartered in Brussels, Belgium. He also was a member of the Defense Policy Advisory Committee on Trade (DPACT) with the Department of Defense and served as chairman of DPACT's Subcommittee on Trade Relations with Japan.

He was the first chairman of two private sector advisory committees to the Federal Government: the Board of Overseers of the Commerce Department's Malcolm Baldrige National Quality Award, and the Defense Department's Defense Manufacturing Board. Murrin was a member of the President's Commission on Industrial Competitiveness in 1984---and was past chairman of the Board of Governors of the Aerospace Industries Association.

Murrin has been invited to speak and write on many topics of significance during recent years---and is, for example, considered to be a national expert on Global Competitiveness and Quality and Productivity Improvement. During 1990, he made over 50 such presentations---and several of these have been published.

Continuing his longstanding involvement with Pittsburgh-area educational institutions, Murrin served as Distinguished Service Professor in Technology and Management at Carnegie Mellon University. He was also Chairman of the Board of Trustees of Duquesne University and a member of the Board of Trustees of Fordham University. He served on the national board overseeing "Cities in Schools," an organization working to reduce school dropout rates. At CMU in 1988, Murrin developed and presented, along with Dr. Steve Miller, a new course titled, "World Class Manufacturing and Global Competitiveness." This course received the fourth highest rating out of 48 courses at CMU's Graduate School of Industrial Administration.

As part of Murrin's community service activities in Pittsburgh, he led a successful fund-raising effort at Mercy Hospital, where he was chairman of the Board for nine years---and participated in similar efforts at Duquesne University and for United Way Drives.

Murrin's honors include: Westinghouse Order of Merit, Westinghouse Electric Corporation (1968); Annual Achievement Award in Business, Fordham University (1976); National Leadership Award, American Productivity Center (1981); James Forrestal Memorial Award, National Security Industrial Association (1983); Election to the National Academy of Engineering (1985); Manufacturing Management Award of the Society of Manufacturing Engineers (1986); Hall of Fame, Cardinal Hayes High School (1988); Honorary Degree of Doctor of Management Science, Duquesne University (1989); and Excellence in Manufacturing Award, National Security Industrial Association (1989).

A native of New York City, Murrin received a bachelor of science degree in physics from Fordham University in 1951, has done graduate work at several universities, and is a fellow of the National Academy of Engineering. He was born April 30, 1929, and is married to the former Dee Coyne of New York City. The Murrins have eight children.

EO 12700**Title 3—The President**

Section 1. Establishment. There is established the President's Council of Advisors on Science and Technology ("Council"). The Council shall be composed of not more than 15 members, one of whom shall be the Director of the Office of Science and Technology Policy, and 14 of whom shall be distinguished individuals from the private sector to be appointed by the President. The Director of the Office of Science and Technology Policy shall serve as Chairman of the Council. The Vice Chairman shall be appointed by the President from among the 14 private sector members. The Chairman shall report directly to the President.

Sec. 2. Functions. (a) The Council shall advise the President on matters involving all areas of science and technology.

(b) In the performance of its advisory duties the Council shall conduct a continuing review and assessment of developments in science and technology, and shall, through the Chairman, report thereon to the President whenever requested.

(c) The Chairman may, from time to time, invite experts to investigate and report to the Council on specific issues of national consequence.

Sec. 3. Administration. (a) The heads of Executive agencies shall, to the extent permitted by law, provide the Council and its panels such information with respect to scientific and technological matters as required for the purpose of carrying out its functions.

(b) Members of the Council shall serve without any compensation for their work on the Council. However, members appointed from among private citizens of the United States may be allowed travel expenses, including per diem in lieu of subsistence, as authorized by law for persons serving intermittently in the Government service (5 U.S.C. 5701-5707).

(c) Any expenses of the Council shall be paid from the funds available for the expenses of the Office of Science and Technology Policy.

(d) The Office of Administration shall, on a reimbursable basis, provide such administrative services as may be required.

Sec. 4. General. (a) Notwithstanding any other Executive order, the functions of the President under the Federal Advisory Committee Act, as amended, except that of reporting to the Congress, which are applicable to the Council, shall be performed by the Office of Administration in accord with the guidelines and procedures established by the Administrator of General Services.

(b) The Council shall terminate on June 30, 1991, unless sooner extended.
