Bonn Police Detain 13 In Probe of Palestinians

BONN—West German police have detained 13 persons and discovered caches of weapons and explosives in an investigation of suspected Palestinian extremists, a judicial spokesman said yesterday after raids in four cities.

Jochen Ruhland, a spokesman for the Duesseldorf prosecutor's office, said that the detainees were under investigation for criminal conspiracy, and arrest warrants have been issued for some of them.

The detainees were suspected of belonging to the Popular Front for the Liberation of Palestine-General Command and had

been planning an attack outside of West Germany, according to security sources quoted by the Reuter news agency. The organization is based in Syria and is headed by Ahmed Jibril.

Pechtel sagte, Polizisten hätten bei der Durchsuchung von insgesamt 18 Wohnun-

gen und Geschäftsräumen in sechs Bundesländern Waffen und Sprengstoff gefunden: „In einer Wohnung in Frankfurt waren vor allem eine Panzerfaust, 25 Granaten - teilweise Gewehr-, Mörser- und teilweise Handgranaten - mehrere Kilogramm Sprengstoff, fast drei Kilogramm TNT, sechs Maschinengewehre, eine Faustfeuerwaffe, zahlreiche Sprengkapseln, Sprengzündler, Munition und Magazine.“ Pechtel berichtete, in einer Neusser Wohnung hätten die Beamten ferner Elek-

tronik entdeckt, die bei Sprengungen verwendet wird. Ferner hätten die Beamten gefälschte Ausweise für verschiedene Länder gefunden. Pechtel wollte nicht sagen, wie die Fahnder auf die Gruppe aufmerksam wurden und verweigerte auch jeden Kommentar zu einer möglichen Beobachtung der Araber schon in den vergangenen Monaten.
