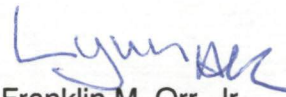
Dear Allan,

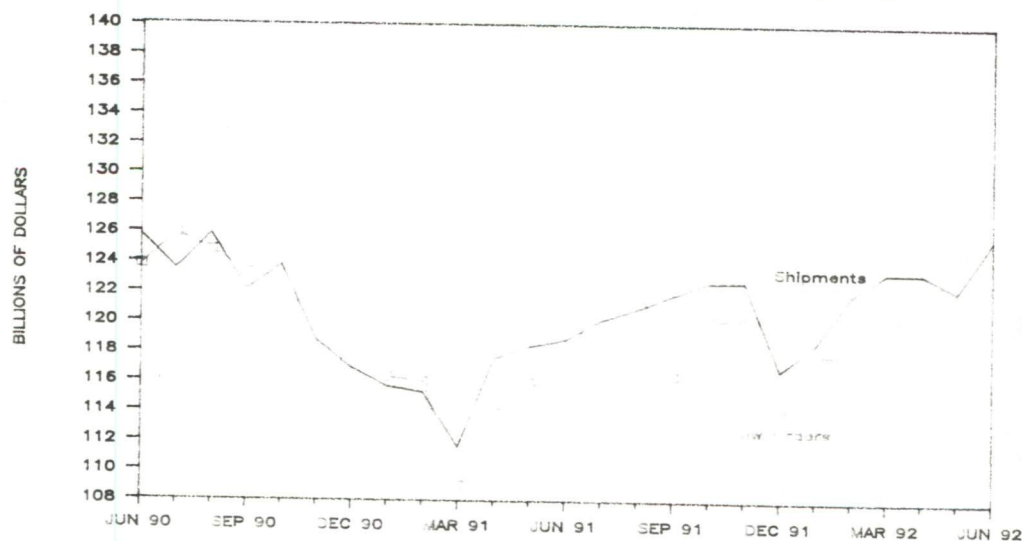
New orders for durable goods rose 2.3 percent in June, the largest increase since January. Private analysts had expected a smaller increase of 1 percent.

The increase in orders in June was widespread across the major industry groups, with instruments and products showing the only decline. The largest increase in orders occurred for industrial machinery and equipment--a positive sign for future durable equipment investment.

Shipments of durable goods increased 2.8 percent in June, the largest increase since February. Shipments of nondefense capital goods--a key measure of producer durable equipment investment--surged 6.9 percent in June, the largest increase in 9 years.

The graph below shows that new orders for durable goods have been volatile over the past year, but at levels above their recession low. Aside from a large decline in December of last year, shipments generally have been increasing, establishing an upward trend from their recession low.
