Tribute will honor fallen cops, troops

THE WASHINGTON TIMES

For 146 police families nationwide last year, the unspoken fear of having a loved one killed in the line of duty became a reality.

And earlier this year, 182 military families experienced similar heartache as a result of Desert Storm combat.

To honor the kinship of those in uniform, law enforcement agencies throughout the country and the military services are planning a joint salute May 14 to the police officers and soldiers who died doing their duty, said Kenneth Allen Adams, president of Moorcroft & Associates, a planning firm that has been hired to organize the salute.

Mr. Adams said yesterday that the commemorative events, including an evening of entertainment at Constitution Hall, are for "those families who have had a part of their hearts forever affected."

"These people are juggling their patriotism and their personal losses. When families were standing at docks and in airports, kissing their loved ones goodbye as they shipped out for the Gulf, many police officers could identify with them because it is the same thing they see every day — wondering if it's the last time you'll ever see your family," Mr. Adams said.

The events will culminate at noon May 15 at the Sylvan Theatre with a two-hour commemorative ceremony on the grounds of the Washington Monument during Law Enforcement Memorial Day, sponsored by the Fraternal Order of Police.

Mr. Adams said his organization decided to expand the annual activities in order to give more family members, officers and soldiers an opportunity to participate. To accommodate their travel to Washington, area hotels and Northwest Airlines are offering cut rates.

"When they leave and go back to wherever they came from, I want them to be able to say, 'I went to Washington and they treated us right,'" he said.

As part of the commemoration, a police wreath will be laid at the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier in Arlington Cemetery on May 14. A musical salute, which will include performances by the Charlie Daniels Band and the Radio City Music Hall Rockettes, will follow that night at Constitution Hall.

Mr. Adams said his organization is mailing 200 appeals today to the District's top businesses, asking that they help sponsor the salute. "We don't need a lot of help but we do need some," he said.

Any surplus funds will be divided equally between two organizations, Concerns of Police Survivors and the Armed Forces Relief Trust.

Tickets for the evening at Constitution Hall, called "A Night in New York, New Orleans and Nashville," are \$25. More than 700 already have been given to relatives of those who died in uniform in the past 15 months, Mr. Adams said.

The evening also will feature performances by the Air Force Ceremonial Brass, a joint service color guard and the New York City Police Pipe and Drum Corp.
