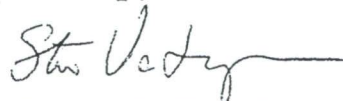

Enclosed with this letter is a copy of our "Proposal for a Federal-State Partnership to Stimulate Competitive Research Capacity" which will serve as the focal point for discussion at our meeting.
