I am delighted to learn that you have been selected as co-recipient of the 1992 Tyler Prize for Environmental Achievement. This is a richly deserved honor.

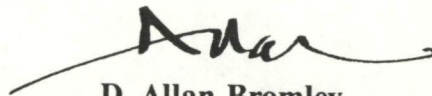

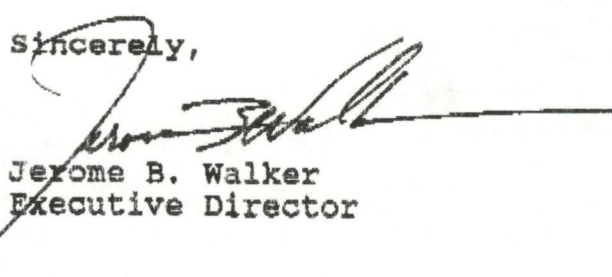
