Dear Allan:

I want to thank you and Karl Erb for seeing Jim Rae and myself on our visit to Washington and for the wonderful mementos of our visit. It was also good to see how comfortably ensconced you are in your "hot-seat".

It was fitting that we were able to see you so soon after the recent announcement by Ottawa that it now wanted to join B.C. and our foreign partners in realizing the KAON project. All of us associated with KAON owe you an enormous debt of gratitude for your unflagging support and especially for the way in which your vision of KAON's science captured the imagination of many Canadian cabinet ministers and the Prime Minister. It also helped all of us that in the midst of global concerns, such as the Gulf war and the collapse of the Russian empire, you helped focus the attention of the U.S. government on the essential nature of its science programs for future prosperity.

Some details about KAON remain to be worked out between Ottawa and Victoria and we need to convert our foreign pledges into appropriate commitments. Your suggestion that we contact Ambassador Derek Burney in order to express our position on U.S. participation in KAON was a good one. We shall follow it up. However, the awesome task of building the project now lies directly ahead. In the course of that there will be many occasion to reflect on your help. When I have the opportunity to visit Washington I may seek again to impose on your hospitality and to share our progress with you.
