Lightning Causes Fire at A-Plant in Massachuset

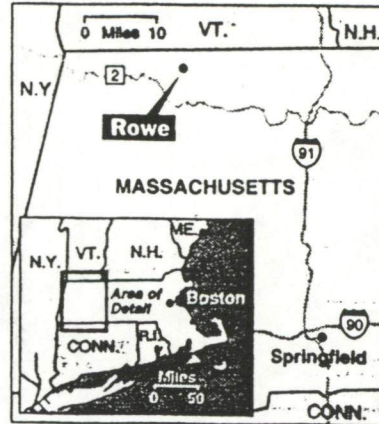
A nuclear plant in western Massachusetts declared an emergency early yesterday after a lightning strike set fire to one of its transformers, knocked out both power lines that bring in electricity for safety systems and shut down its telephone switchboard.

No one was injured, and there was no release of radiation.

The plant, Yankee Rowe, 35 miles east of Albany and a mile south of the Vermont border, was operating at full power when an electrical storm struck the area in the Berkshire Mountains. But workers began a shutdown process without difficulty, and the reactor was expected to reach a complete shutdown about 8 A.M. today.

Lightning struck one of Yankee's three transformers at 11:50 P.M. on Saturday. "We get hit with lightning several times every year and usually we can ride them out," said William J. McGee, a plant spokesman. "But this was a humdinger."

Operators on duty declared an unusual event, the least severe category of emergency, at 12:17 A.M. yesterday, but the shift supervisor declared an alert, the next-highest category, at 1:30, after evaluating the damage. After consulting with Massachusetts and Vermont officials, the operators

The plant's status will continue to be classified as being that of an unusual event until the reactor reaches "shutdown," when the water in the cooling system is below the boiling point at atmospheric pressure, Mr. McGee said.

With no power available from outside, emergency diesel generators were started to provide electricity for pumps and valves. The plant has backup telephones that continue to work, one of which was taken over by the resident inspector for the Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Mr. McGee said. The fire was put out by the plant fire brigade, he said.

Yesterday plant workers were checking equipment for hidden damage from power surges and seeing what repairs and parts were needed to resume operations, Mr. McGee said.

Yankee Rowe, which began operations in July, 1961, is the oldest operating commercial reactor in the United States. Its owners, a group of New England utilities led by Northeast Utilities of Berlin, Conn., are planning to apply for a renewal of its operating license which will expire in 2000. But groups are concerned about nuclear safety assessments that the metal of the reactor vessel has become too brittle for continued safe operation.

Emergency Generators Used

The Nuclear Regulatory Commission requires that an alert be declared when "events are in process or have occurred which involve an actual or potential substantial degradation of the level of safety of the plant."
