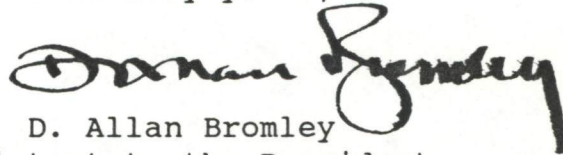
Dear Dr. Wilkerson:
