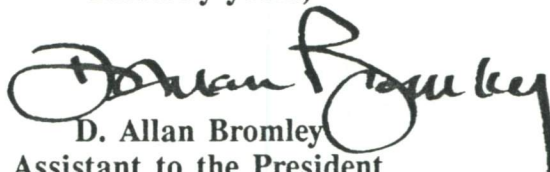
Dear Mr. Frischkorn:
