AUTHORITY: 7 U.S.C. 1738i
P.L. 101-624, Title XV, Sec. 1511, 104 Stat. 3661,
November 28, 1990 (establishes)
E.O. 12757 of March 19, 1991 (defines governmental
representatives, chairperson, and vice chairperson)

METHOD: Appointed by the President

MEMBERS: NINE, as follows:

Five representatives from the United States Government
One from the Department of State;
One from the Department of the Treasury;
One from the Environmental Protection Agency;
One from the Agency for International Development;
One from the Inter-American Foundation;

Four representatives from private nongovernmental
environmental, community development, scientific,
and academic organizations with experience and
expertise in Latin America and the Caribbean.

CHAIRPERSON: Representative from the Department of the Treasury
appointed by the President

VICE
CHAIRPERSON: Representative from the Department of State appointed
by the President

TERM: Pleasure of the President

SALARY: No provision

PURPOSE: The Board shall - (1) advise the President and the
Secretary of State on the negotiations for the
environmental framework agreements described in
subsections (a) and (b) of section 607; (2) ensure, in
consultation with the government of the appropriate
eligible country, with nongovernmental organizations of
such eligible country, and if appropriate, of the region,
and with environmental, scientific, and academic leaders
of such eligible country and, as appropriate, of the
region, that a suitable body referred to in section 607(c)
is identified; and (3) review the programs, operations,
and fiscal audits of the bodies referred to in section
607(c).
