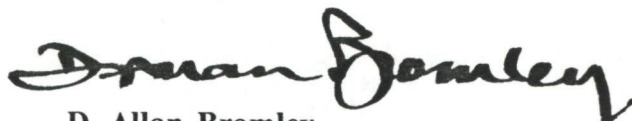
Dear Mr. Hart:
