The President today announced his intention to nominate Henry Lee Clarke, of California, a Career Member of the Senior Foreign Service, Class of Minister-Counselor, to be Ambassador of the United States of America to the Republic of Uzbekistan.

Since 1989, Mr. Clarke has served as Economic Counselor of the American Embassy in Tel Aviv, Israel. Prior to this, he served as Deputy Chief of Mission at the American Embassy in Bucharest, Romania, 1985-1989; and Economic Counselor at the American Embassy in Moscow, U.S.S.R., 1982-1985. From 1980-1981, Mr. Clarke served as Officer-in-Charge of Trade and Industrial Policy in the Office of European Regional Political-Economic Affairs for the United States Department of State.

Mr. Clarke was graduated from Dartmouth College (A.B., 1962) and Harvard University (M.P.A., 1967). He was born November 15, 1941 in Fort Benning, Georgia. Mr. Clarke served in the United States Army, 1962-1965. He is married, has two children and resides in Turlock, California.
