2. EMBASSY LAGOS WELCOMES THE PLANNED PRIVATE VISIT TO NIGERIA OF MR. AND MRS. JEB BUSH AND THEIR ASSOCIATES FROM M&W PUMP. WE WILL WORK CLOSELY WITH M&W PUMP REPRESENTATIVES IN NIGERIA TO HELP MAKE THE VISIT A SUCCESS. THE VISIT PROVIDES AN EXCELLENT OPPORTUNITY TO SHOWCASE THE MUTUAL BENEFITS OF US INVESTMENT.
3. AT THE INVITATION OF ALHAJI INDIMI OF M&W PUMP THE AMBASSADOR AND OTHER MISSION OFFICERS WILL ATTEND THE DEDICATION CEREMONIES IN MAIDUGARI MARCH 3-5. WE EXPECT THAT DURING THE LAGOS STOPOVER ON MARCH 7 HIGH LEVEL NIGERIAN OFFICIALS WILL WANT TO RECEIVE MR. BUSH. AS DISCUSSED IN ELLER/BLAKEMORE TELECON FEBRUARY 14, AMBASSADOR AND MRS. LYMAN PLAN TO HOST A RECEPTION FOR THE VISITING PARTY THE EVENING OF MARCH 7 IN LAGOS.
4. ALTHOUGH THE VISIT IS PRIVATE, WE BELIEVE IT IS IMPORTANT TO SUBMIT TO THE DEPARTMENT A THREAT ANALYSIS IN ADVANCE OF ANY US VIP VISIT TO NIGERIA. WE NOTE THE PROXIMITY OF MAIDUGARI TO CHAD, WHERE A DEGREE OF POLITICAL INSTABILITY PERSISTS. WE PLAN TO SEND THE RSO TO MAIDUGARI AND KANO EARLY NEXT WEEK TO MAKE A FIRST

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HAND SECURITY ASSESSMENT, WHICH WILL BE FORWARDED TO THE
DEPARTMENT. LYMAN
