FROM AMEMBASSY LAGOS

TO SECSTATE WASHDC PRIORITY 9159

SUBJECT: NIGERIA GOES ALL OUT FOR JEB BUSH VISIT

1. SUMMARY. NIGERIA PULLED OUT ALL THE STOPS TO GREET MR. AND MRS. JOHN ("JEB") BUSH ON THEIR FIVE DAY VISIT TO NIGERIA IN CONNECTION WITH THE DEDICATION OF THE M&W PUMP PLANT IN MAIDUGURI. THE BUSHES LED A DELEGATION OF TWENTY-ONE PERSONS THROUGH FIVE DAYS AND FIVE CITIES OF CEREMONIES, DEDICATION, RECEPTIONS, DINNERS, A DURBAR, MEETING WITH THE PRESIDENT, AND A RECEPTION IN LAGOS ATTENDED BY NUMEROUS HIGH LEVEL OFFICIALS AND DIGNITARIES. CROWDS APPLAUDED ALL THE WAY, WITH AT LEAST 100,000 PEOPLE AT ONE STOP LINING THE STREETS CHEERING. THE FMG PROVIDED EXCELLENT SECURITY, GRACED THE DEDICATION OF THE PLANT WITH THE PRESENCE OF TWO MINISTERS AND FIVE STATE GOVERNORS AS WELL AS A HIGH RANKING GENERAL AS REPRESENTATIVE OF THE PRESIDENT, SHOWERED THE DELEGATION WITH ATTENTION AT EACH STOP, AND PUBLICIZED THE EVENTS EACH NIGHT ON NATIONAL TV. JEB BUSH ELOQUENTLY PRESENTED THE INTEREST OF THE US AND THE AMERICAN PEOPLE IN CLOSER US-NIGERIA RELATIONS, THE POSITIVE CONTRIBUTIONS OF THE PRIVATE SECTOR, AND THE VALUES OF A PARTNERSHIP IN DEVELOPING BOTH TRADE AND DEVELOPMENT TIES. PRESIDENT BABANGIDA WARMLY WELCOMED BUSH AND SENIOR MEMBERS OF M&W PUMP IN LAGOS. MINISTER OF EXTERNAL AFFAIRS FOLLOWED WITH HIS OWN MEETING. THE VISIT WAS THE GRANDEST CELEBRATION OF US-NIGERIA FRIENDSHIP WE HAVE SEEN IN RECENT MEMORY, AND PROMOTED GREATLY THE POTENTIALS IN CLOSER TRADE AND INVESTMENT TIES BETWEEN OUR TWO COUNTRIES. END SUMMARY.

2. JEB BUSH, SON OF PRESIDENT GEORGE BUSH, AND HIS WIFE COLUMBA ARRIVED MARCH 3 TO DEDICATE THE M&W PUMP PLANT IN MAIDUGURI, A CITY IN NORTHWEST NIGERIA ONLY AN HOUR FROM THE CAMEROUN AND CHAD BORDERS. M&W'S PLANT WAS ASSISTED WITH A USD 52 MILLION EXPORT-IMPORT BANK GUARANTEE AND REPRESENTS THE HIGH POINT OF 17 YEARS OF INVOLVEMENT BY M&W IN NIGERIA. THE PLANT WILL MANUFACTURE IRRIGATION PIPES AND LATER ASSEMBLE PUMPS, OF WHICH M&W HAS ALREADY OVER 1,000 OPERATING IN NIGERIA. M&W PRESIDENT DAVID ELLER AND OTHER M&W PUMP OFFICIALS FROM FLORIDA, MEXICO AND TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO ACCOMPANIED THE BUSHES. AMBASSADOR AND MRS. LYMAN, ALONG WITH COMMERCIAL COUNSELOR AND CONGEN KADUNA AND WIVES ACCOMPANIED PARTY THROUGHOUT. ALHAJI MOHAMMED INDIMI, CHAIRMAN OF M&W PUMP, NIGERIA (LTD.), WAS THE OFFICIAL HOST AND MADE EXTRAORDINARY ARRANGEMENTS FOR THE VISIT.

3. THE VISIT BEGAN WITH TWO DAYS IN MAIDUGURI WHERE IN ADDITION TO THE DEDICATION OF THE PLANT, THERE WERE CALLS UPON THE GOVERNOR OF BORNO STATE AND THE SHEHU OF BORNO (SECOND HIGHEST RANKING MUSLIM LEADER IN NIGERIA), VISIT TO THE CHAD BASIN DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY TO SEE PUMPS IN OPERATION AND AGRICULTURE FLOURISHING THEREWITH, HORSE RACING (MAJOR SPORT IN MAIDUGURI), AND SEVERAL RECEPTIONS AND DINNERS. THE GOVERNOR OF BORNO HOSTED A DINNER AND A LUNCH FOR ABOUT SEVENTY PERSONS EACH, PLUS A LARGE COCKTAIL PARTY. GOVERNORS OF GONGOLA, NIGER, PLATEAU, AND BAUCHI WERE ALSO IN ATTENDANCE. PRESIDENT BABANGIDA WAS REPRESENTED BY MAJOR GENERAL GARBA DUBA, GOC OF THE THIRD ARMORED DIVISION AND A MEMBER OF THE ARMED FORCES RULING COUNCIL. MINISTERS OF EDUCATION AND AVIATION ALSO ATTENDED WITH THE FORMER MAKING AN ELOQUENT TOAST TO US-NIGERIA TIES.

4. NEXT STOP WAS BAUCHI FOR A CALL ON THE GOVERNOR AND A VISIT TO GOMBE, SITE OF M&W ACTIVITY IN SUPPORT OF AGRICULTURE. THE EMIR OF GOMBE PRESIDED OVER A DURBAR, A TRADITIONAL NORTHERN NIGERIA CELEBRATION WHICH EXCEEDED ANY WE HAVE SEEN. SOME 1300 HORSEMEN, WITH ELABORATE FINERY AND TRADITIONAL COSTUME, THE HIGHEST RANKING MEMBERS OF THE EMIRATE AND NUMEROUS CIVIC GROUPS PARTICIPATED. THE CLIMAX WAS THE EMIR HIMSELF LEADING A CHARGE OF SALUTE TO THE BUSHES. SOME 100,000 PEOPLE CROWDED INTO GOMBE FOR THE EVENT, LINING THE STREETS (WHICH WERE DECORATED WITH AMERICAN AND NIGERIAN FLAGS) AND CHEERING THE ENTOURAGE AS IT PASSED. TO THE SURPRISE EVEN OF THE EMIR, THE BAUCHI STATE GOVERNOR DROVE TWO HOURS TO GOMBE TO ATTEND THE EVENT AND ARRANGED TO SEE THE BUSHES SOME FIVE TIMES DURING THE ONE DAY IN HIS STATE.

5. THEN TO KANO, NIGERIA'S THIRD LARGEST CITY, STARTING WITH A DINNER THAT INCLUDED THE CREAM OF KANO SOCIETY, A CALL THE NEXT DAY ON THE GOVERNOR AND ON THE EMIR OF KANO (THIRD RANKING MUSLIM LEADER OF NIGERIA). THE PARTY THEN FLEW TO LAGOS.

6. PRESIDENT BABANGIDA RECEIVED THE SENIOR MEMBERS OF THE DELEGATION IN HIS OFFICE (MEETING COVERED SEPTEL, NOTAL). BABANGIDA RECALLED WITH PLEASURE HIS MEETING WITH PRESIDENT BUSH IN TOKYO AND WELCOMED JEB BUSH, WHOSE TRAVEL THE PRESIDENT HAD FOLLOWED CLOSELY. MINISTER OF EXTERNAL AFFAIRS NWACHUKWU RECEIVED THE DELEGATION AND SPOKE OF HIS APPRECIATION OF GOOD TIES BETWEEN OUR TWO COUNTRIES AND HIS STRONG INTEREST IN

PROMOTION OF AMERICAN PRIVATE INVESTMENT. BOTH THE PRESIDENT AND MINISTER PRESENTED THE BUSHES WITH GIFTS AND BUSH PRESENTED THE PRESIDENT WITH A SPECIAL SOUVENIR OF THE INAUGURATION.

7. LUNCHEON WAS THEN HOSTED BY INTERNATIONAL MERCHANT BANK ATTENDED BY BOTH MINISTER OF PETROLEUM (AND PRESIDENT OF OPEC) AND MINISTER OF FINANCE PLUS NIGERIAN AND AMERICAN BUSINESSMEN.

8. ON FINAL EVENING, AMBASSADOR HOSTED A RECEPTION FOR SOME 300 PEOPLE INCLUDING THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE, A JUSTICE OF THE SUPREME COURT, CHAIRMAN OF THE NATIONAL POPULATION COUNCIL, PRESIDENT OF THE BAR ASSOCIATION, SEVERAL MEMBERS OF THE CONSTITUENT ASSEMBLY AND AMERICAN AND NIGERIAN BUSINESS REPRESENTATIVES.

9. COMMENT. THE FMG SAW THIS VISIT AS A SPECIAL SIGN OF FRIENDSHIP BETWEEN THE TWO COUNTRIES AS WELL AS AN OPPORTUNITY TO ADVERTISE NIGERIA'S RECEPTIVITY TO PRIVATE INVESTMENT. 


