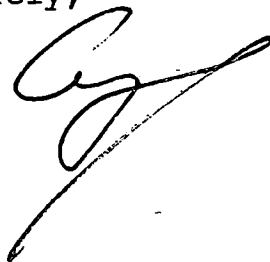
Dear Mr. President:

- o Although he wanted to be ambassador to Argentina, where he's traveled often, Mr. Holden will accept your offer.
- o He is now largely retired, having owned two life insurance companies and three mutual funds. He was on Bob Mosbacher's list of prime recommendation among Team 100 members to be considered for an ambassadorship.
