SUBJECT: IMF/World Bank Spring Meetings *AB 4.9*

The spring meetings of the IMF and World Bank have just been completed. They represented a major step forward in our efforts to strengthen the international debt strategy. They also provided an opportunity for us to review our G-7 economic policy coordination process, including exchange rate developments.

International Debt Strategy

There was broad support for the proposals I presented in my Bretton Woods speech, including:

- ✓ o Renewed emphasis on sound economic policies in debtor countries, particularly measures to encourage domestic savings, investment, and repatriation of flight capital;
- ✓ o An increased focus on debt and debt service reduction to complement new lending to debtor countries;
- ✓ o Modification of IMF and World Bank lending policies to support reductions in debt burdens; and
- ✓ o Stronger commercial bank support for the strengthened debt strategy.

Of equal importance to the broad support we received was the sense of urgency for action and the specific support for use of IMF and World Bank resources to facilitate debt reduction. This level of specificity was unprecedented in G-7 and IMF Ministerial agreements. Japan has also announced its intention to provide \$4.5 billion over the next few years in parallel with use of IMF/World Bank resources to support our debt proposals.

Nevertheless, difficult negotiations lie ahead to develop fully and implement the new approach. In particular, concerns have been raised about use of IMF and World Bank resources for interest support. We will be working actively with the IMF and World Bank to resolve these concerns. At the same time, we will continue to work with individual debtors, such as Venezuela, Mexico and the Philippines. In the last few days, I have met with financial officials from each of these countries, as well as other debtors.

Economic Policy Coordination

At the G-7 meeting, the other Summit countries emphasized the need to achieve further reduction of the U.S. budget deficit and to prevent renewed inflationary pressures from emerging. They believe this is critical to lowering the U.S. trade deficit and avoiding still higher interest rates. I provided them a status report on the budget negotiations, although they remain skeptical, and stressed the need for Germany and Japan to maintain adequate domestic demand growth and adopt structural reforms to reduce their large trade surpluses.

✓ In addition, the G-7 agreed to continue close cooperation in foreign currency markets, particularly to deal with a further rise of the dollar that would hurt our competitive position. This appears to have been helpful as the upward pressure on the dollar has eased since the G-7 statement.

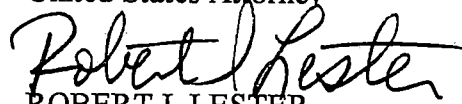

This is a personal letter to send my warm greetings to you on the occasion of the celebration of your twenty-first birthday.

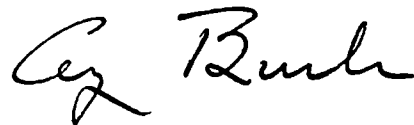
The bearer of this message is my close personal friend of long standing, Mr. Jack Fitch.
