H.J.Res. 380 is designed to recognize the contributions of "patient account management personnel" who provide the information necessary for operation of the Nation's complex health care systems. The enrolled resolution designates October 18, 1989, as "Patient Account Management Day." It also requests the President to issue a proclamation calling upon the people of the United States to observe the day with appropriate ceremonies and activities.

H.J.Res. 380 was not delivered to the White House until after the designated day. Accordingly, a draft proclamation has not been prepared for your consideration and issuance.
