MEMORANDUM FOR THE PRESIDENT

FROM: The Secretary of State *J.H.B.*
SUBJECT: Post Malta Talks with Soviets on Central America

1. On the trip over to Malta, Brent and I agreed that I should follow up on your remarks to Gorbachev on Central America with a more detailed discussion with Shevardnadze. Brent and I also agreed on a set of specific demands that we would ask of the Soviets and on a set of responses the U.S. would take if those demands were met. A copy of these points is enclosed.

2. I was able to meet with Shevardnadze during your one-on-one with Gorbachev and discussed chemical weapons and other subjects, but because of the schedule problems we encountered I did not have time to get into Central America. I told Brent that I would raise these points with Shevardnadze immediately upon my return to the U.S. and I have done so. *11*

✓ 3. By telephone Thursday morning I stressed again the point you made to Gorbachev: that our ability to move forward on the agenda you laid out would be affected by events in Central America. I said that the status quo in Central America would not hold: events there would either get better or worse and that Soviet actions toward Nicaragua and Cuba would determine which direction they went. I also stressed the importance of making progress in both the elections in Nicaragua and the conflict in El Salvador lest a crisis in either mar the atmosphere for the June summit.

4. Shevardnadze, while not commenting on the enclosed points I outlined, made several general points: First, he said that Nicaragua and Cuba are "sovereign governments," "to take these commitments we (the Soviet Union) have to assume a special responsibility." Second, he suggested in light of our conversation that the Soviet Union would "have to have another very serious conversation with Nicaragua and Cuba even though we just had a visit." Third, he said Soviet "possibilities in El Salvador are very limited, but we will take another look at what the Nicaraguan leaders can do."

Shevardnadze reacted particularly favorably to the steps I outlined which the U.S. would take if our requests were met. The Soviet Union has argued strongly in our regional discussions on Central America that their ability to pressure Nicaragua and Cuba depended in part on our willingness to respond politically, to positive steps Nicaragua and Cuba might take.

5. Finally, we agreed that Yuri Pavlov, head of the Latin American Division of the Soviet Ministry of Foreign Affairs, and Assistant Secretary Aronson, should meet again soon to follow up on our conversation. At Shevardnadze's request I cabled through our Ambassador in Moscow the enclosed copy of the points I reviewed by phone, but asked that they be kept out of the system because of their sensitivity.

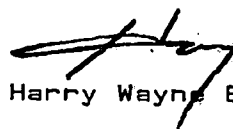
Dear Ambassador Han Xu:

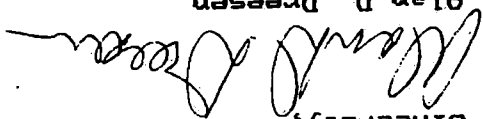

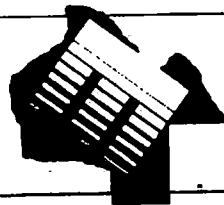
