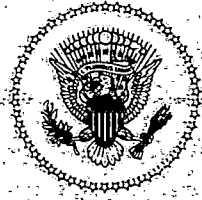

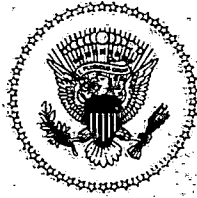

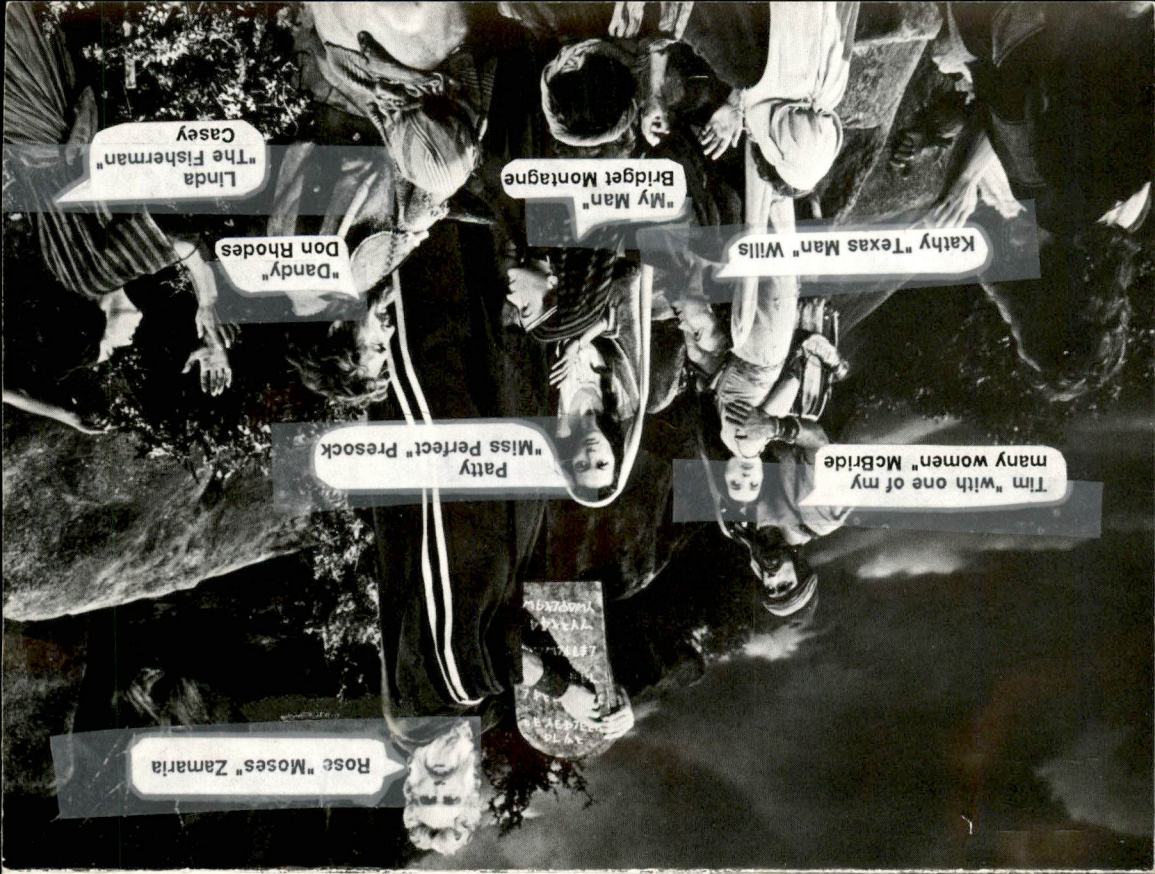

One year after Cecil B. DeMille's *The Ten Commandments* opened in New York in 1956, it was still playing to packed houses, an event Bosley Crowther called "a phenomenon almost beyond compare." Crowther could be forgiven for a bit of DeMillean exaggeration: The film had already grossed \$26 million, despite a nationwide box-office slump.

Judged solely by box-office receipts, *The Ten Commandments* was an important film. But it was also a remarkable technical achievement. Weighing in at a record \$13 million budget and 220-minute running time, *Commandments* served up the usual DeMille stew: equal mixtures of reverence and spectacle.

DeMille was shrewd enough to realize the value of eye-popping legions of extras, lavish sets and costumes, and, above all, special ef-

fects. For years, the standard in movie wizardry was *The Ten Commandments'* parting of the Red Sea.

DeMille also understood the value of casting. He had a knack for finding actors like Charlton Heston (as Moses) and Yul Brynner (as Rameses) to portray his larger-than-life heroes and villains. The result was spectacle with a vigor that many screen epics seem incapable of achieving.

DeMille had made *The Ten Commandments* before, as a silent film in 1923. The biblical story was mixed with a modern one, to less impressive results.

"No one knows what the public wants," DeMille wrote in 1927. Thirty years later, as if anyone still doubted it, he had proved himself wrong again.

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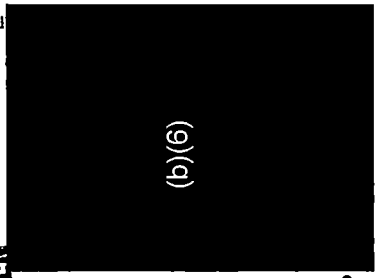

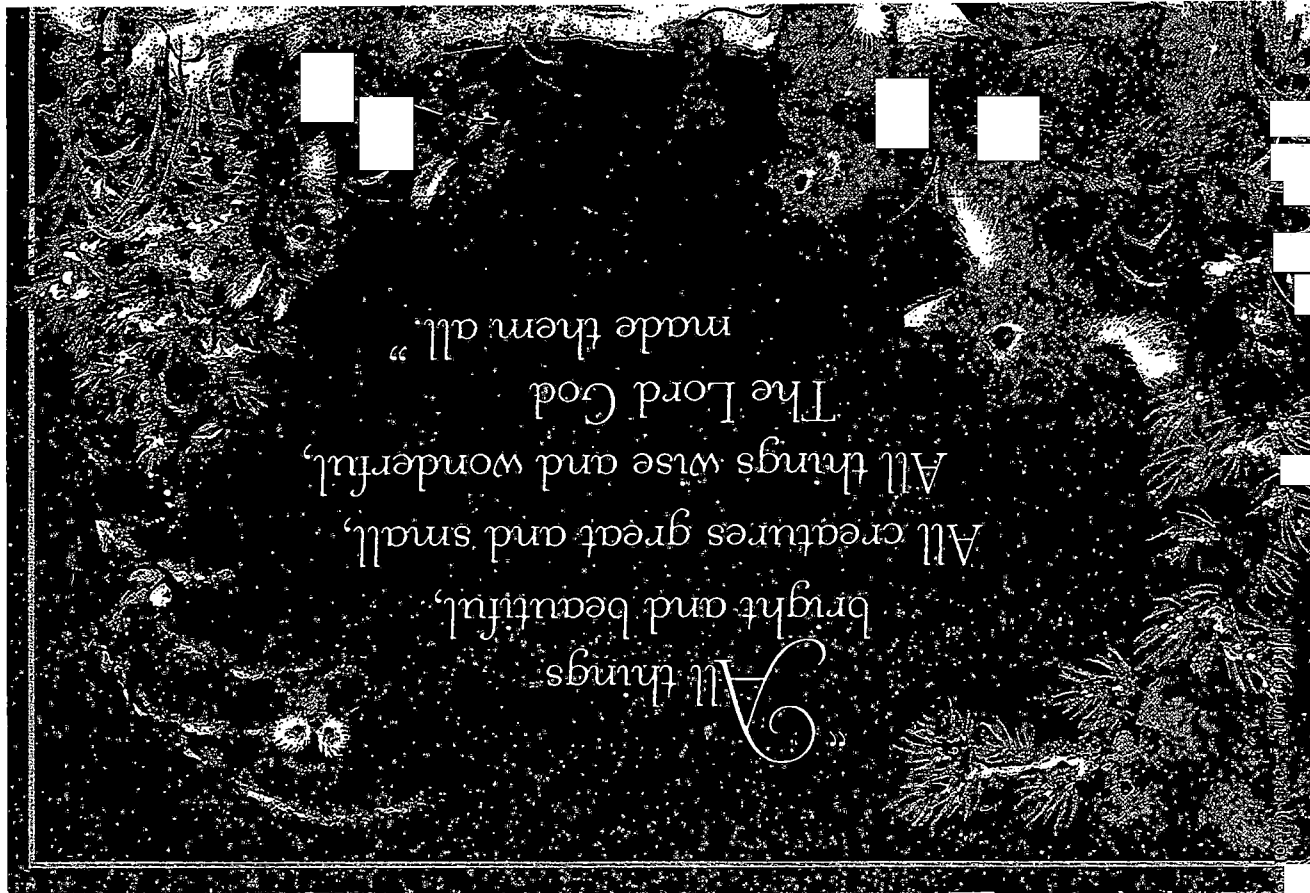
