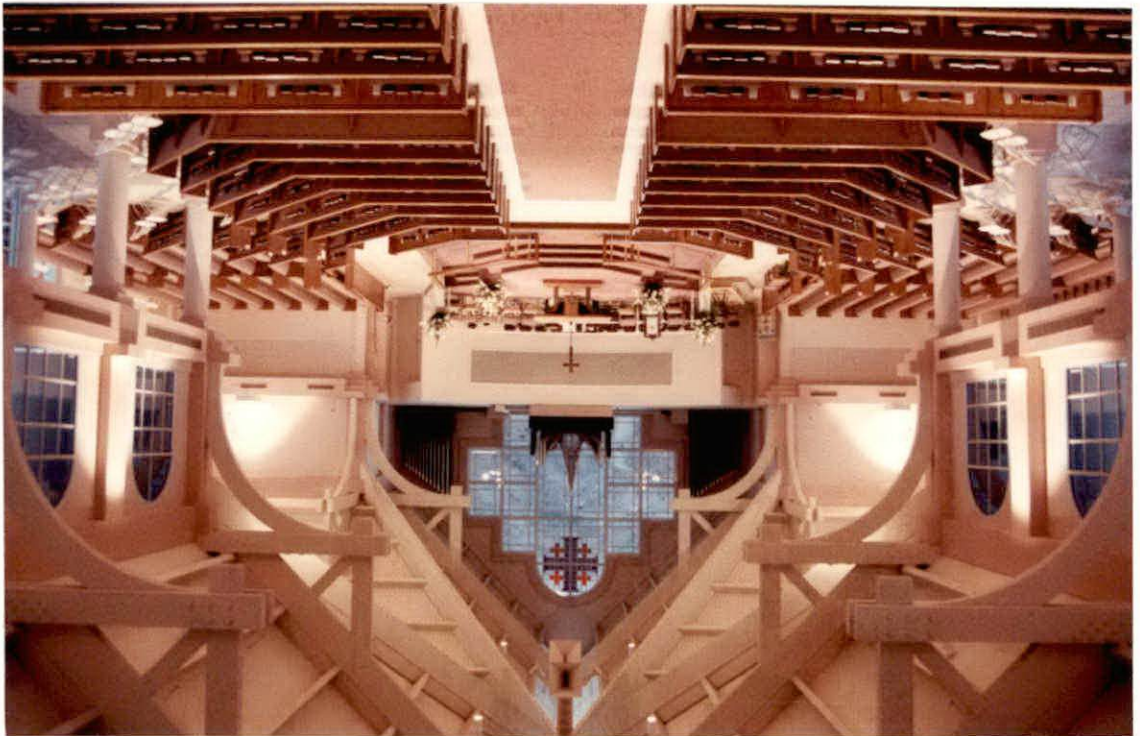

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ADDENDUM TO POOL REPPORT # 10

March 4, 1990

There was a minor scuffle at the end of the Q&A with Mr. Annenberg as Mr. Edley moved in to cut-off apparently embarrassing questions. Mr. Annenberg was asked to explain his comment on blacks needing to prove they have the capacity to teach and serve. He responded, "What did I mean by that, the record would explain that."

Q: What's that record?

A: "The record of excellence that blacks have achieved on an individual basis. George Washington Carver, there are any number of blacks with tremendous records. I'm sure you're aware..."

At this point Mr. Edley jumps in front of the camera and steers Mr. Annenberg away. When challenged by a reporter, Mr. Edley said, "We've limited the questions, I'm sorry sir."

The reporter charged that Mr. Edley was "editorializing." Mr. Edley responded by calling the reporter an "ass," and spirited Mr. Annenberg off toward the house. A full transcript of this exchange may be available through NBC.

President Bush basked in his post-summit after-glow and looked ahead to playing as many holes of golf as possible this morning, but first he took a break near a well-manicured green to congratulate Walter Annenberg on his gift of \$50 million to the United Negro College Fund.

Highlights of this report include a few Presidential words on the summit and some Q&As with Mr. Annenberg that were not recorded by the White House. Most of the Bush comments are available in transcript. There wasn't much that you could really call news.

The day began with a trip to St. Margaret's Episcopal Church in Palm Desert for a private mass beginning at 7 a.m. Jay Allison said the President's plans to attend the 8 a.m. regular service were changed after the local paper printed the schedule. Mr. Bush didn't want to "impose" on the other church-goers, he said. When pressed, Jay said security concerns might also have been involved since the change in plans did not eliminate any imposition. Lots of church-goers were inconvenienced in the parking lot, and others came early to gawk, anyway. Jay did deny reports that Mr. Bush moved up his church schedule to have more time for golf, however.

The 35-minute service was also attended by Nick Brady and his wife, and Donald and Adele Hall, of the Hallmark Halls. Mrs. Hall was later a participant in the United Negro College Fund event.

Your pool was not allowed in the chapel where the service was held...We saw the President and First Lady only as they drove away, in a limo newly affixed with flags. (They must have been traveling incognito on the way over.)

The First Couple returned to the Annenberg estate for "coffee on the veranda", says Gary Fendler, before the UNCF event began about 8:45 a.m.

Some words on the estate. It is everything you dreamed it would be. Two hundred and five acres of beautifully manicured lawns and golf greens. The trees of many varieties had to be brought in full grown, said some in the pool who seemed to know about such things. The house is a sprawling, one-story modern structure done in white ceramic tile. It doesn't really look like a house, more like a modern synagogue or a meeting hall. But it sits on top of what might have been a man-made hill in the middle of the desert. The view from the veranda is spectacular, all grass, trees, duck ponds and snow-capped mountains. You would never know you were in the desert, or even that you were surrounded by several towns full of people and race balls.

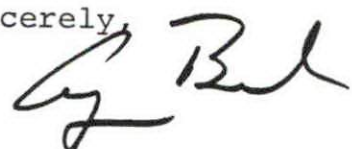
