Mrs. Bush swam on Friday afternoon, and Saturday and Sunday mornings.

Tennis Court

The President and guests played tennis Sunday.

Chapel Service

Chaplain Weyand conducted Catholic Service at 0730 in the Hickory Theater. Twelve crew members/staff attended. Chaplain Fred Rothermel conducted an inter-denominational service at 0900. President and Mrs. Bush, family, guests, and 85 crew members and dependents attended.

- President's dog found a dead rabbit at staff pool and delivered to Mrs. Bush. (Duty Section Removed)
- Mrs. Bush requested a stainless steel water bowl be placed at Wye Oak. (Duty Section and MS1 Minnie located)

- USSS cart would not operate. Operator error on key switch. (CM1 Gillette instructed)
- Mothballs required for packing items in Aspen. (Duty Section responded)
- Driving range at Helo Pad received extremely well by the President.
- John and Billy Bush received tour of Marine ONE on Sunday.
- Extra VCR was placed in Dogwood for Margaret Bush children.

- Mr. McBride sponsored a St. Patrick's "Irish" Party at Shangrila Lounge Saturday night for guests and staff.

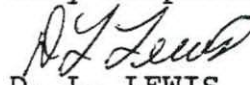

Exit polls and electronic projections indicate the center-right "Alliance for Germany" will win today's election.

The latest projections show the Alliance-CDU with up to 53 percent of the vote, to about 21 percent for SPD, and 13 percent for the Communists.
