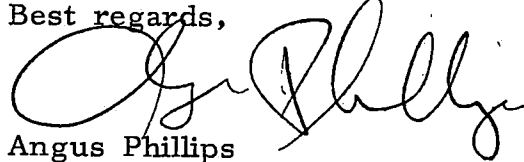
It was good fun talking fishing with you the other day, and I hope our planned bass trip on the Potomac in April works out. I called Glenn Peacock, my favorite Potomac guide, to say I had a VIP guest coming and he was all for it.

I'm enclosing a column I did a couple of years ago on a September day spent with Peacock, listing some of the close-by hotspots for bass that we hit, with considerable success. Late April is traditionally every bit as good as early fall, the major difference being that the weather and river conditions are more unpredictable in the spring. But the bass are bigger.
